TERMINATION OF SERVICES FOR ALL CASUAL WORKERS WITHIN KILIFI COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICE

Hon. Mwayaa: THAT; Aware that Section 74 of the County Governments Act, 2012 provides that the County Public Service Board shall regulate the engagement of persons on contract, voluntary and casual workers, staff of joint ventures and attachment of interns in Public bodies and offices.

Aware that the County Public Service Board has not yet submitted to the County Assembly Regulations for the engagement of persons on contract, volunteer and casual workers, staff of joint ventures and attachment of interns in Public bodies and offices for approval.

Noting with concern that County Chief Officers have engaged persons on contract and casual basis with neither knowledge nor guidance from the County Public Service Board nor approval of regulations by the County Assembly.

This County Assembly urges the County Secretary to direct all the County Chief Officers to terminate services of all the casual workers within the County Public Service with an exception of casuals from all dispensaries until the County Assembly approves the regulations for the engagement of persons on contract, volunteer and casual workers, staff of joint ventures and engagement of interns in County Public Service Bodies and offices.
