## PETITION ON CONSULTATION OF THE PUBLIC IN BUDGET REVIEW

**The Speaker** (Hon. Kahindi): Hon. Members, my Office is in receipt of two Petitions. Pursuant to Standing Order No. 196 1 (a) of Kilifi County Assembly, I wish to Report them to the House. The first Petition is from the members of Kilifi County Trade Union Forum and Civil Societies petitioning this House concerning the insufficient public hearing forum on the Budget estimates for the financial year 2018/2019 especially pertaining to the Health Department.

The Petitioner prays that the County Assembly through the responsible Departments informs them on:-

One, the progress of service improvement vis-à-vis recruitment of more staff and steady supply of essential and adequate drugs and non-pharmaceuticals.

Two, the progress of the Auditor General's Report and recommendations on utilization of funds on HRM (Human Resource Management) and of procurement of drugs and non-pharmaceuticals.

Three, a Report on the internal and external donors supporting the Department of Health to which extent.

Pursuant to Standing Order No. 203 this petition stands committed to the Sectoral Committee on Health Services to be considered within 60 calendar days.

## EMPLOYMENT DISCRIMINATION AGAINST THE LEAST PRIVILEGED KILIFI RESIDENTS
