REDUCTION OF THE PUBLICATION PERIOD FOR THE KILIFI COUNTY
SUPPLEMENTARY APPROPRIATION BILL (ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 6), 2016

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwambire): Hon. Pascal, please.

Hon. Pascal: Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir, for giving me an opportunity to present to this House the procedural Motion on the reduction of publication period of the Kilifi County Supplementary Appropriation Bill, Assembly Bill Number (6), 2016.

THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order No. 116, this County Assembly approves the Publication period for the Kilifi County Supplementary Appropriation Bill Assembly No. 6, 2016 be reduced from seven days to five days. Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwambire): Anybody to second him?

(Hon. Hassan stood at his place to second)

Yes hon. Hassan is seconding. Hon. Members, the Motion to reduce the Publication Period for the Kilifi County Supplementary Appropriation Bill, Assembly Bill No. (6), 2016 has been tabled and successfully seconded. It is now up for debate.

(Question proposed)

Yes hon. Mangi.

Hon. Mangi: Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir. I rise to support this Motion. Mr. Speaker, the passage of the Appropriation Bill will pave way for monies to be used; either recurrent or development. You will agree with me that the passage of the Appropriation Bill is long overdue and this was caused by the Executive arm of the government and at this particular moment we are giving a notice to the Executive to respect the timelines that are given in the Budget process to avoid such delays in future. I appeal to hon. Members to support this Motion so that we may conclude the supplementary budget once and for all. Mr. Speaker, I support the Motion. Thank you.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwambire): Hon. Matano.

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Hon. Matano: Asante Mheshimiwa Spika. Nami nimesimama kuunga mkono Mswada huu kwa sababu kupita kwake ni muhimu maana itafungua shughuli zetu za kaunti. Kuna shughuli nyingi upande wa *Executive* zimesimama na hata hapa kwetu Bungeni. The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwambire): Hon. Nzaka

Hon. Nzaka: Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir, for giving me this chance. I stand to support this Motion. In fact, the Executive should have brought this Appropriation Bill on time. As we speak, there are some services which are delayed. This is because we cannot access money from the Supplementary Budget we passed without passing this document.

In my Department there are some care givers who were to be recruited this financial year. There are about 200 Early Childhood (ECD) care givers but we cannot employ them because we have not passed this document. In fact, if at all we will not pass this document Mr. Speaker, Sir, even the salaries of the staff from the Executive and the County Assembly and even myself, I think I will not give anything without passing this document. So I urge my fellow hon. Members to kindly pass this Motion so that we can access the fund from the Controller of Budget and this should be a notice to the Executive.

Next financial year, they should not bring this document late. They should bring this document in time so that the Committee on Budget can make use of this document accordingly without delay. My pocket is dry Mr. Speaker Sir, because of this document. Even the fuel, I cannot move because of this document so I urge my fellow hon. Members, kindly pass this document so that we can speed up the operation of this great County. Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwambire): Hon. (Ms.) Chiku Wanje.

Hon. (Ms.) Chiku: Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir, for giving me this chance to support the Motion. Mr. Speaker, I think it is quite in order to reduce the number in the shortest time if possible 24 hours because as what hon. Nzaka has said our pockets are really dry and we are about to even take *matatus* (Public transport) coming to work because we cannot even afford to drive to the Assembly. With those few remarks, Mr. Speaker, I urge the hon. Members to support this Motion. Thank you.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwambire): Hon. Pascal, respond please.

(Question, that the Mover be now called upon to reply, put and agreed to)

Hon. Pascal: Thank you Mr. Speaker. Let me start by thanking all the Members who have contributed. I think from the contributions that have just been made by my fellow hon. Members, you find that almost everybody is in support of this Motion and even if it were possible two days would even be better as Members have indicated. The issues of contractors and workers not being paid as my friend has put across, are issues that call for the immediate passage of this Motion Mr. Speaker. So I would not like to circumnavigate. I rest my case by thanking all the Members who have positively contributed to the Motion. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwambire): Hon. Members, the procedural Motion on reduction of the publication period for the Kilifi County supplementary and Appropriation Bill has been tabled and debated.
