DEATH OF FOUR DAY OLD INFANT AT MALINDI SUB-COUNTY HOSPITAL

Hon. Mramba: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I beg to seek a Statement from the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Health Services through the Chairperson, Health Services Committee. This is in regard to death of four day old infant at Malindi Sub-County Hospital.

Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of Health Services is aware that on the 19th Day of April, 2019, a four day old infant named Elvis Ruwa Gona was referred from Madunguni Dispensary and admitted at Malindi Sub-County Hospital. Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of Health Services is aware that the infant was not attended to for more than twelve hours since there was no oxygen at the Malindi Sub-County Hospital for use in the ambulance to enable a further referral to Coast General Hospital.

If yes, why was there lack of oxygen in Malindi Sub-County Hospital which is essential for emergencies and referrals to other health facilities and what measures have been put in place to ensure that patients are attended to promptly and Malindi Sub-County Hospital has sufficient pharmaceutical and non-pharmaceutical products? POOR WORKING CONDITIONS AT BRILLIANT GARMENT COMPANY LTD AND AMORYCOCO COMPANY LTD IN MTEPENI WARD

Hon. Gogo: I rise to seek a Statement to the County Secretary through the Leader of Majority on poor working conditions at Brilliant Garment Company Ltd And Amorycoco Company Ltd in Mtepeni Ward.

Whether the County Secretary is aware that casual, contract and permanent workers at Brilliant Garment Company Ltd and Amorycoco Company Ltd in Mtepeni Ward are working under poor conditions such as long working hours without compensation, low wages, no defined responsibilities, and inadequate safety equipment among others.

Whether the County Secretary is further aware that the harsh working conditions in the two companies have resulted in health and social complications of the workers, If yes, the County Secretary is urged to commission an inspection of the said companies and report to the County Assembly on the measures taken to address the concerns raised in this Statement.
