#### DELAYED COMPLETION OF ICT LABORATORY AT JARIBUNI POLYTECHNIC

**Hon. Mwarandu:** Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir. It is a Response to a Statement sought by hon. Maitha Masha, Member for Jaribuni Ward. It is about the construction of a laboratory at Jaribuni Polytechnic and this is what is sought;

Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Education and ICT is aware the construction of ICT laboratory which was in the financial year 2016/2017 Budget is not complete? If yes, what measures has the Department taken to ensure the completion of this project?

The Response from the CECM is as follows:

Reference is made to your letter dated 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2018 Ref. No. AK/ADM/3/VOL.18/10 on the above subject matter. We would wish to confirm that the mentioned project was completed in October, 2017. There are no pending works except that the project is not connected to electricity. This is because the allocation that was set aside for the project was not enough for electricity connection.

We have set aside Ksh.9,043,874 for connection of all our ICT laboratories in the next financial year 2018/2019 Budget. Regards Prof. Gabriel Katana Gona, CECM Education and ICT.

DELAYED CONSTRUCTION OF KIREPWE ECD CENTRE

Then the next Response was again hon. Daniel Chai Chiriba responding to a Statement by hon. Emmanuel Changawa.

**Hon. Kenga:** Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir. I have been asked by the Vice-Chairperson, Education given that I am a Member of the Education Committee to take over because the Chairperson is not present and the Mover of the Statement is the Vice-Chairperson. So I will read on his behalf. I apologize for my voice because I am down with flu and my voice may not be very clear.

**The Temporary Speaker** (Hon. Thaura): It is okay hon. Member, go ahead.

**Hon. Kenga:** The Statement was sought by hon. Changawa, the Member for Dabaso Ward. It was to the County Executive Committee Member in charge of the Department of Education and ICT through the Chairperson, Pre-Primary Education and Vocational Training Committee on Kirepwe Early Childhood Development Centre.

The Statement was; Whether the County Executive Committee Member in charge of the Department of Education and ICT is aware that the construction of two- number class rooms at Kirepwe ECD centre was allocated Ksh3.2 million in the approved financial year Budget 2014/2015, the amount was re-voted in the financial year 2016/2017 Supplementary Budget and further allocation of Ksh66,870 was allocated in the approved estimates for the financial year 2017/2018 but the project has not yet kicked off.

If yes, what measures has the Department taken to ensure the completion of this project? By the Member for Dabaso dated 11<sup>th</sup> April, 2018. The Response from the CEC Member was as follows;

Response on County Assembly Statement sought by hon. Changawa, MCA Dabaso Ward. The Statement inquired to know why construction of Kirepwe ECD centre had not yet started despite funds for the same being allocated in financial year 2014/2015, revoted in 2016/2017 and a further allocation in the financial year 2017/2018.

In Response, I wish to state as follows; One, Kirepwe is located in an island so the initial allocation of Ksh3.2 million was not enough to build the project to completion. However the

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MCA then advised the centre to be build at Mzizima Pre-school and the Department complied. The same is now complete and in use.

Two, the Department has in the FY 2018/2019 budget, proposed an allocation of Ksh5.3 million to build two class rooms and two toilets to completion for Kirepwe ECD centre. By Professor Gabriel Katana Gona, the Executive Committee Member in charge of Education and ICT. Thank you.

**The Temporary Speaker** (Hon. Thaura): Thank you. The Member for Dabaso, are you contented with the Response?

**Hon. Changawa:** Asante msheshimiwa Spika kwa kupata nafasi hii ili kukubaliana na majibu ya Waziri juu ya swali ambalo nililiuliza. Nakubaliana na haya majibu kwa namba ya pili lakini ile sababu ya kwanza kwamba pesa haikutosha hio nafikiri kwangu hazingetosha lau pesa hazingewekwa ili madarasa haya kujengwa ndani ya Bajeti ya mwaka wa 2018/2019.

Wakati waziri anasema pesa hazikuwa zinatosha; naona tumekuwa na maswala ya *pending bills*, ya kwamba mradi umewekewa pesa kidogo lakini utanza na kama pesa hazitatosha baadaye utaongezewa pesa. Kama pesa zitatolewa na mradi utoke mahali umeelekezwa ufanywe uwekwe mahali kwengine, basi naona haitakuwa desturi nzuri.

Kama ilifanywa huko nyuma, kwangu naomba jambo kama hili lisifanyike tena. Ni kweli ECD ya Mzizima iko ambayo haikuwa kwa Bajeti lakini Bajeti hiyo ya Kirepwe ambako ni kisiwa ndio iliyotolewa huko ikajengwa Mzizima.

**The Temporary Speaker** (Hon. Thaura): Yes hon. Member for Gongoni.

**Hon. Kiraga:** Thank you so much Mr. Speaker. I believe the Response has answered the Statement and that is a fact. Secondly, on the concerns being raised by the Member, I think we need to advise each other because I believe this was a Ward Development Fund (WDF) project and the Member by then in consultation with the Members of the public, had Ksh3.2 million for that project and probably when the Executive went to the ground, these monies could not be enough as it has been stated.

When some further consultations were made then the hon. Member by then hon. Hamza Hassan thought it better instead of taking this project to that area of which the amount could not be enough, they suggested another area where, Mr. Speaker, I think this amount could now be sufficient. More so, if it is a WDF project, who is now to refund when the money is not enough? It is the Member himself in consultation with the public to refund it with the next allocation of WDF? I think we stand to be guided when it comes to such matters. Thank you.
