MARERENI FISH DEPOT

Hon (Ms.) Sidi: Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir. I stand on behalf of hon. Stanley Kenga Member for Adu Ward who is the Speaker today, to seek a Statement addressed to the County Executive Committee Member in charge of the Department of Agriculture, Livestock Development and Fisheries about Marereni Fish Depot:-

Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in Charge of Agriculture, Livestock Development and Fisheries is aware of the status of Marereni Fish Depot construction in Adu Ward. If yes, why has the project which first featured in the FY 2013/2014 budget not been completed until now? How much money has been paid to the contractor as of today? What action is the CECM in charge taking to ensure the completion of the project?

BARICHO, KAKUHANI, ZHONGWANI PRIMARY SCHOOLS

Hon. Ziro: Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir. I rise to read a Statement to the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of Education and ICT through the Chairperson Pre-primary Education and Vocational Training. I am referring to Baricho, Kakuhani and Zhongwani Primary Schools:-

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Whether, the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of Education and ICT is aware that there is a complete two classroom project at Baricho Primary School but the classrooms are ready but they have been locked and pupils are learning under a tree.

Whether the CECM is aware that the toilet projects at Kakuhani and Zhongwani Primary Schools are complete but not accessible to the pupils? If yes, what measures has he taken to counter these problems? Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Is the Chairperson for Education Committee present? I can see that the Vice Chairperson is present. Please make sure that within a period of 14 days from today you are able to bring a comprehensive Response to the Statement that has been sought by the Member. BANDARI, RIMARAPERA AND SHIRANGO DISPENSARIES

Hon. Mwambire: Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir, I want to seek a Statement from the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Health Services through the Chairperson Health Services Committee on Bandari, Rimarapera and Shirango Dispensaries:-

Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Health Services is aware that the above named dispensaries are not operational? If yes, what actions and plans has the CECM made to ensure they are functioning? Thank you.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Thank you very much hon. Member. Is the Chairperson for the Department of Health present? The Vice Chairperson? Do we have any Member in the Health Committee within the County Assembly of Kilifi? There seems to be a challenge that the Chairperson for the Health Committee and the Vice-Chairperson are not present today but the Clerks-at-the-Table will be able to communicate to either the Chairperson or Vice-Chairperson to make sure that a Response is given to this Assembly within a period of 14 days.
