## NOTICES

### THE KILIFI COUNTY TAX WAIVER ADMINISTRATION BILL, 2014 (COUNTY ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 3 OF 2014)

Notice is given that the chairperson of the Budget and Appropriations Committee intends to move the following amendments to the Kilifi County Tax Waiver Administration Bill, 2014 at the Committee Stage—

#### **CLAUSE 2**

Clause 2 of the Bill is to be amended by inserting the following new paragraph immediately after the words 'responsible for finance;'

'Chief Officer' means the person appointed by the County Governor to administer the county department responsible for financial affairs.

#### **CLAUSE 5**

Clause 5 of the Bill is to be amended as follows: –

- (a) In paragraph 5(1) the word 'Governor' is to be replaced with 'County Executive Committee'.
- (b) In paragraph 5(2), part (c) should be deleted.

#### **CLAUSE 6**

Clause 6 of the Bill is to be amended by deleting the paragraph and inserting the following new paragraph: -

- “(1) Where the executive committee member intends to waive any tax, he or she shall submit the proposed waiver to the County Assembly seven days before the waiver is granted.”
- “(2) Every waiver shall be published in the County Gazette not more than fourteen days after it is granted.”

#### **CLAUSE 7**

Clause 7 is to be amended as hereunder: -

- (a) In paragraph 7 the words 'executive committee member' are to be replaced with 'Chief Officer'.
- (b) Paragraph 7(b) is to be replaced by inserting the following new paragraphs –

“(i) not later than two months after the end of each financial year, submit to the County Assembly a report of each waiver and the reason for it.

(ii) not later than three months after the end of each financial year, submit to the Auditor General a report of each waiver and the reason for it.

**CLAUSE 9**

Clause 9 to be amended by substituting paragraph (1) with the following new paragraph:-

“The executive committee member may, with the concurrence of the County Executive Committee, and approval of the County Assembly, make regulations for the better carrying out of the provisions of this Act.”
