## **NOTICES**

### **THE KILIFI COUNTY REVENUE ADMINISTRATION BILL, 2014** **(COUNTY ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 5 OF 2014)**

Notice is given that the chairperson of the Budget and Appropriations Committee intends to move the following amendments to the Kilifi County Revenue Administration Bill, 2014 at the Committee Stage—

#### **Clause 2**

Insert a new definition immediately after the definition on the rate, to read as follows:

- i). "revenue" means rates, charges, levies, fees, rents, royalties and any monies payable to the County Government as revenue under any written law;
- ii). "Executive Member" means the County Executive Committee Member for the time being responsible for finance;
- iii). "tax payer" unless the context otherwise provides, means a person who is obligated under any county or national law to pay to the county any rates, fees, rents, royalties or levies or charges that are prescribed under any county law to be a tax.

#### **Clause 3**

Delete Clause 3(2) and replace with the following:

To qualify for appointment as a County Revenue Collector, a person must:

- a) Possess a degree in finance, accounting, economics, business, law or related field from a recognized university;
- b) Has at least five years post-qualification professional and relevant experience;
- c) Is a member of a professional body; and
- d) Satisfies the conditions of chapter six of the Constitution.

#### **Clause 4**

4 (1) (c) Delete the words "county government" and replace with 'County Executive Committee Member for Finance'

#### **Clause 6**

After a lengthy discussion, the committee recommended that clause 6 be deleted and an adoption be made to section 160 of the Public Finance management Act which states that "the County Executive committee member for finance may authorize the Kenya Revenue Authority or appoint a collection agent to be a collector of County Government revenue for the purpose of this part on such terms and conditions as may be agreed in writing in accordance with the regulations," provided that such decision to privatize collection of revenue shall be approved by the County Assembly.
