STATEMENTS

1. Hon. Dr. Silas Mzungu Chitibwi - The Chairperson Water and Sanitation Committee

I rise to seek a statement from the chairman of the sectoral committee on Water and Sanitation on the following.

1. Whether the chairperson, is aware that the only Institution providing health care services in Mwarakaya Location – Namely Kizingo Dispensary has operated without any supply of water.
2. Whether the chairperson is aware that the community lobbied for and a water pipeline was laid down to serve the dispensary and the surrounding community of Kizingo village in 2009 and 2010 but still water is not yet available?
3. Whether the chairman is aware that the water provider – KIMAWASCO used excuse that water could not be supplied until a booster pump and storage tanks provided for storage of water?
4. Whether the chairman is aware that after lobbying by the community, one 50 cubic meter ferrocement tank and one 20 cubic meters plastic tank were installed at the dispensary in 2011 and 2010 and not a drop of water has been supplied to the dispensary and community with a real danger that both tanks may crack even before they are used.
5. What is the County Executive Committee member for Water, Environment and Natural Resources doing to ensure that Public Investment does not go to waste and members of the Public get the essential services which have been brought to their “doors”

2. Hon. Dr. Silas Mzungu Chitibwi – The Chairperson Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries

I rise to seek a statement from the Chairperson of the sectoral committee on Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries.

1. Whether the Chairperson is aware that several farmers were encouraged by staff of the Department of Agriculture to form a common group to pursue dairy farming in Mwarakaya and Chasimba Wards with a promise that they will each be provided with two dairy cows on loan once they had met a few basic requirements which are:-
 - i. Demonstrate availability of land for each individual farmer.
 - ii. Plant at least one half of an acre nappier grass.

- iii. Each farmer to construct a zero-grazing shed for the cows and expected offspring.
 - iv. Provide security for the total value of the number of cows that would be loaned to the group.
 - v. Each farmer to make regular monthly savings in a joint account to serve as their monetary contribution.
2. Whether the chairperson is aware that up to 260 farmers came together and formed the required group through four clusters and each met their individual requirements and also the joint requirement of security.
 3. Whether the chairperson is aware that after more than one year of regular meetings, education seminars/workshops conducted by officials of the department of livestock, members were informed by the same officers that the lender who had been identified by the department namely co-operative bank of Kenya and Agricultural Finance Corporation had pulled out of the scheme.
 4. Whether the chairperson is aware that officers of the department of livestock have abandoned this group since mid 2014 and all their investments on their individual land has or is going to waste?
 5. What is the department of Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries doing to ensure that the farmers' investment does not all go to waste and their hope to raise their socio-economic status does not die?
