**ELECTRICITY CONNECTION TO TSANGATSINI VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE IN
KAYAFUNGO WARD**

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Chairperson for the Committee on Education make your request. Thank you.

Hon. Chiriba: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I rise in Response to a Statement sought by hon. Alphonse Mwayaa and for our recap I will go through our Statement.

Whether the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Education and ICT is aware that Tsangatsini Vocational Training Centre in Kayafungo Ward has not been connected to electricity hence hindering effective learning and operations of machines.

If yes, what measures is the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Education and ICT taking to ensure that the said Vocational Training Centre is connected to electricity?

Hon. Chiriba: From the CECM, Reference to your letter dated 12th of November 2019, number CAK/DPT/ECD/3/VOL. 1/35 regarding the statement on electricity connection to Tsangatsini Vocational Training centre in Kayafungo Ward.

The Department confirms that this electrical installation was to be done in 4 classrooms. Only wiring has so far been done using the budget allocation of Ksh. 1,698,994 that has been provided for in the supplementary budget. However, for electrical connectivity to be done there is need of a transformer at the centre whose cost is Ksh.1, 037,996.00 (see attached). At the moment we don't have a transformer near the centre.

The Department is aware of the need and will provide an allocation for the provision of the transformer in the next Financial Year budget.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Yes the Member for Kayafungo Ward.

Hon. Mwayaa: Thank you Mr. Speaker, since it will be provided for in the budget, I agree with the Chairperson Education.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): The Response given is satisfactory to the Member who sought the Statement then the matter should be considered settled.

MOTION

REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH MOBILE CLINICS

THAT, Aware that, a majority of women and girls in Kilifi County are faced with reproductive health challenges.

FURTHER AWARE THAT, these women suffer for lack of proper information and support from concerned officials.

CONCERNED THAT, Kilifi County has also been ranked top in early pregnancies cases with statistics from Children's' Department alluding that 14,000 girls succumbed to teenage pregnancies in 2018.

ALIVE TO THE FACT THAT, early pregnancies expose teenage mothers to a wide array of health complications including but not limited to pre and post-natal depression, fistula and nutritional deficiency;

NOW THEREFORE, this Honorable House urges the Department of Health Services in collaboration with the Department of Gender and Social Services to set up reproductive Health mobile clinics in every sub-county that shall focus on delivering reproductive health care including screening and treatment.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): I am informed that the Notice of Motion was supposed to be read yesterday but it was not read. So the matter is referred to the House business committee which shall be sitting tomorrow to allocate time for it.
