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## NOTICES OF MOTIONS

### ESTABLISHMENT AND DEVELOPMENT OF A SPORTS ACADEMY

**Hon. Hadad:** I beg to give Notice of the following Motion:-

THAT, aware that the Fourth Schedule Part II of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, empowers counties to develop sports, cultural activities and facilities.

FURTHER AWARE THAT, sports activities have a unique power to attract, mobilize, inspire, empower and create employment opportunities as well as being a high impact tool in creating positive alternatives to youth anti-social behaviours and crime.

COGNIZANT OF THE FACT THAT, the Bomani Community in Magarini Ward has available land with approximated coverage of 25 acres that can be used for the establishment of a sports academy to tap talents among the youths of Kilifi County.

This House urges the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Gender, Social Services, Culture and Sports to allocate funds for the establishment and development of a County Spots Academy at Bomani in Magarini Ward in the financial year 2018/2019.

### TERMINATION OF 15 YEAR CONTRACT OF RAIN DROPS LIMITED

**Hon. (Ms.) Sidi:** Thank you, Mr. Speaker, Sir. I stand on behalf of Hon. Kiraga to give a Notice of Motion to the Department of Finance and Economic Planning:-

THAT, aware that Section 160 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012, provides that the County Executive Committee Member for Finance may authorize the Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA) or appoint a collection agent to be a collector of the County Government revenue.

FURTHER AWARE THAT, the County Government of Kilifi contracted the services of a company called Rain Drops Limited to collect some streams of revenue on behalf of the county for 15 years.

NOTING WITH CONCERN THAT, the County Government has not been able to realize its local revenue targets even after the private company came into place.

This House urges the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Finance and Economic Planning to immediately initiate measures for terminating the 15 year contract of the private company and authorize KRA to be a collector of the County Government Revenue.

### SOLAR POWERED BOREHOLES

**Hon. Kenga:** Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I am standing on behalf of the hon. Member for Mwanamwinga Ward, Pascal Jacob Thuva, who is also a Member of the Budget Committee currently held up on official business with the Budget Committee.

I beg to give the following Notice of Motion to the County Executive Committee Member in charge of the Department of Water, Environment, Natural Resources, Forestry and Solid Waste Management on solar powered boreholes:-

THAT, aware that every person has a right to clean and safe water in adequate quantities as provided for in Article 43(1) (d) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.

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FURTHER AWARE THAT, provision of water is a devolved function.

NOTING WITH CONCERN THAT, Ganze, Magarini and Kaloleni Sub-Counties of Kilifi County are categorized as arid and semi-arid areas which experience drought and famine almost every year.

This House urges the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Water, Environment, Natural Resources, Forestry and Solid Waste Management to initiate measures that will see at least 10 solar powered boreholes are dug in each of the three Sub-Counties so as to provide enough water for domestic and agricultural use to save the residents from abject poverty and suffering.
