The Leader of Majority (Hon. Mwingo): Thank you, Mr. Speaker, for giving me this opportunity to read the following Motion:-

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwambire): Yes, hon. Mwayaa make your contributions towards the Motion.

Hon. Mwayaa: Asante mheshimiwa Spika. Nataka kuchukua nafasi hii kuunga mkono Hoja ambayo imeletwa na kiongozi wa wengi katika Bunge hili la Kaunti yetu ya Kilifi.
