NOTICES OF MOTION

CONDOM DISTRIBUTION

Hon. Kiraga: Thank you very much Mr. Speaker. I wish to move the following Notice of Motion.

AWARE THAT, HIV/AIDS is one of the diseases contributing to most of the deaths in our County. Noting with concern that the prevalence rate in Kilifi County is among the highest in the country despite the fact that the County Government of Kilifi has condoms in its pharmacies.

FURTHER AWARE THAT, as a method of preventing the spread of this deadly disease and other related sexual transmitted diseases, condom use is very vital.

This House therefore, urges the County Executive Committee Member (CEC) in charge of health services to facilitate the distribution of condoms in the designated areas like washrooms of all public premises and encourage the private sector to do likewise.

Secondly, I would also wish to move a Notice of Motion to the Department of Health Services.
