LACK OF STREET LIGHTS FROM KIBAONI TO MKOROSHONI
ALONG MOMBASA-MALINDI HIGHWAY

Hon. Mumba: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I rise to seek a Statement from the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Roads, Transport and Public Works through the Chairperson, Transport and Public Works Committee:-

Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Roads, Transport and Public Works is aware that street lighting is a mandate of the County Government as provided for in the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010?

Whether the CECM is aware that, the stretch from Kibaoni to Mkoroshoni along the Mombasa-Malindi highway does not have street lights which have brought about a spurt in insecurity (robbery) especially to women and students as well as affecting business operations?

If yes, what plans does the Department have to ensure street lights are installed to enhance safety and security for the residents and businesses?

If yes, one; what were the reasons for constructing these *bodaboda* sheds on a road reserve? Two, what is the Department doing to have these *bodaboda* sheds re-built at those mentioned stages?

STATUS OF MTONDIA TOILET IN TEZO WARD

Whether the CECM in charge of the Department of Trade, Tourism and Co-operative Development is aware that Mtondia toilet is complete?

If yes, why has the project not been handed over to the Community?
