If yes, why the delayed electricity installation and what measures is the CECM in charge of Education and ICT taking to ensure Msumarini Vocational Training Centre is connected to electricity?

STALLED CONSTRUCTION OF CLASSROOMS AT VUGA AND KULALU ECD PROJECTS IN ADU WARD
