PROMOTING ECDE HOME SCHOOLING DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC PERIOD

Hon. Kenga: Thank you. With me is a Statement directed to the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of Education and ICT through the Chairperson of the Committee on Education and ICT:-

Whether the County Executive Committee Member is aware that the COVID-19 pandemic has led to the closure of all schools in the Republic hence stopping all learning in all ECDE (Early Childhood Development and Education) centres in the county.

If yes, what measures and programmes is the county putting in place to ensure that the pupils are able to access learning at this difficult time of the pandemic? Thank you very much.

Whether the County Secretary (CS) in charge of the County Public Service is aware that there is a National Policy on Gender and Development, 2019 spearheaded by the National Gender and Equality Commission (NGEC) meant to achieve gender equality and women empowerment in the country.

Whether the CS is aware that the County Governments are supposed to be implementers of the Policy to ensure that key thematic areas outlined in the Policy that is; labour and employment, health, land, housing, agriculture, environment and natural resources, peace and security, governance, sexual and gender-based violence are integrated into county Sectoral polices, planning and programmes?.

Whether the CS is aware that the NGEC formulated a leadership guide on integration of gender equality and inclusion in the county development to assist in the implementation of the gender and development policy.

If yes, what actions has he taken to ensure that this Policy is implemented at the county level? Thank you.
