Hon. (Ms.) Ngala: Hon. Members welcome to the Committee of the Whole House. The rules are relaxed to enhance debate. We are now going through the Kilifi County Vocational Training and Education Bill, 2016. Madam Clerk please proceed to read the clauses.

Clause 3

Hon. (Ms.) Mbeyu: Madam Chairperson, I beg to move:-

THAT, Clause 3(b) be amended by deleting the word “young” between the words “by” and “persons” and replace it with “all “ to read as “Acquisition of occupational trade skill by all persons through training.”

(Question, that the word to be inserted in place thereof be inserted, put and agreed to)

THAT, Clause 7(1) (b) be amended by deleting “holds a degree from a university recognized in Kenya” and replace with “a member of the board to have a minimum qualification of Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education” to read as, “No person shall be appointed to the board under sub-section 1 above unless; the person has a minimum qualification of Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education, be a person of integrity and committed to serve the community on voluntary basis.”

REPORT AND CONSIDERATION OF REPORT

KILIFI COUNTY VOCATIONAL TRAINING AND EDUCATION BILL, 2016

Hon. (Ms.) Ngala: Hon. Speaker, I beg to report that the Committee of the Whole House has considered the Kilifi County Vocational Training and Education Bill, Assembly Bill No. 12, 2016 and approved the same with amendments. Thank you.

Hon. (Ms.) Mbeyu: Hon. Speaker, Sir, I beg to move that the House do agree with the Committee in the said Report and I call upon hon. Emanuel Chai to second.

(Hon. Chai seconded)

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwambire): Yes hon. Emmanuel Chai you have seconded. Please make your contributions.

Hon. Chai: Thank you Mr. Speaker for giving me a chance to stand in support of the passage of this Bill. First, as I have seen it will be of importance as the Bill is talking about the changing of Youth Polytechnics to Vocational Trainings which is at least a wider area where even somebody older like me can attend these institutions instead of only the youth. I think most of our Youth Polytechnics at the moment are in very pathetic conditions just because of mismanagement and as I have gone through the Bill, I think it will bring up good management as the Board of management at least will come and have good management on how to run these institutions.

It will be a good thing for us at least to allocate money from our county towards those institutions so that most of our training centres can be recognized and not remain the way they are now because they are in a very bad condition. So, I will be very happy if this Bill is passed with all these amendments so that we can have good management in Vocational Training Centres. Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir.
