Hon. Mwayaa: Asante sana mheshimiwa Spika. Kusema kweli, Bunge hili tunapitia hali ya huzuni kwa kupoteza mwenzetu ambaye alituacha wiki iliyopita. Kwa hali hiyo, itabidi tukamzike yule mwenzetu.

I want to believe that it was a wise decision for us as hon. Members to be given time so that we can articulate the issues of the budget.

Mr. Speaker, if as at now we are not yet ready with the budget, it is also an indication of growth. When we came into this House, we used to just pass issues without understanding them but we are growing. We cannot just pass matters that we have not understood and more so, are not convincing. The Speaker (Hon Kahindi): Thank you hon. Chiriba. You began by crawling now you are walking.

(Laughter)

Yes, hon. (Ms.) Nashee.

Hon. (Ms.) Nashee: Asante mheshimiwa Spika kwa kunipa nafasi hii. Nami naunga mkono. Ningeomba tukimaliza hayo mazishi, tuwe na muda wa kupumzika lakini katika hiyo hali ya kupumzika kwa sababu tulikubali kuwakilisha watu wetu, hapa ni kufanya kazi usiku na mchana hatutapumzika.

Ni vizuri tukakae na hiyo bajeti ili tuiangalie na tuijadili kama Bunge zima kwa sababu ni kamati peke yake iliyokalia hiyo bajeti... Sisi kama wajumbe wateule tunawakilisha kaunti nzima na tuna haki ya kutetea watu wote. Tuiangalie hiyo bajeti kama kuna mahali wengine wamelemewa ambao hawako katika hiyo kamati tuweze kuwatetea. So, for me I will applaud the chairperson for bringing the Adjournment Motion so that we can sit and scrutinize it so that when we come to the Assembly we pass it.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you hon. Chai.

Hon. (Ms.) Kwekwe: Asante Bw. Spika kwa kunipa nafasi hii. Mimi pia naunga mkono kuahirishwa kwa huu wakati ili tukawe pamoja kwa hizo siku mbili kuangalia bajeti hii. The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you.

Hon. Dele: Thank you hon. Speaker for granting me this opportunity to applaud the idea of adjournment of this hon. House. This hon. House by virtue of the 2010 Constitution which is well stipulated, it is in order for the House to articulate issues in the budget. The whole issue is very constitutional and for the rights of *Kilifians*. I hope we will be justifying each and every thing by articulating the budget. I support the idea.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you hon. Dele.

Hon. (Ms.) Mwaro: Asante sana mheshimiwa Spika na Bunge kwa jumla. Mimi nasimama kuunga mkono mheshimiwa Nzaro aliyesimama kwa niaba ya kiongozi wa wengi Bungeni, kwa kuleta Mswaada huu wa kusitisha shughuli za Bunge hadi siku ya Jumatano.

Naomba kuchangia kwamba tuweze kukusanyika pahali patakapokuwa pamechaguliwa ili kupitia ile Ripoti ya bajeti. Tunajua maswala ya kupanga bajeti ni nyeti kwa hivyo yanahitaji muda kupitia maana mheshimiwa Spika, kuna sehemu nyingi zimepangiwa pesa za maendeleo. Hata hivyo utakubaliana nami kwamba mbali na sehemu hizo kunayo makundi ambayo yanahitaji kushughulikiwa hususan kitengo cha watu wenye ulemavu.

Bajeti zilizopita hapo awali kunazo pesa ambazo naweza kuzitaja ni shilingi milioni 10 ambazo ziliwekwa kwa bajeti, na tunaona kuwa pesa hizo hazikuweza kutumika katika bajeti za nyuma. Ni huzuni kwa sababu kuna watu ambao wanapaswa kuhudumiwa kupitia hizo pesa. Sasa ni wakati mzuri tukae na kupitia kipengele baada ya kipengele tuone kama kuna mahali pamezidi papunguzwe na kuongeza palipopungua ili watu wetu wa Kaunti ya Kilifi wahudumiwe vyema na pesa zinazopangwa na Bunge hili na kaunti nzima kwa jumla. Nasimama kuunga mkono kuchambua bajeti ile ili kila jambo liweze kulingana na vile ambavyo Kaunti ya Kilifi inapenda kuendesha shughuli zake. Asante.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you hon. (Ms.) Mwaro.

Hon. Pascal: Thank you Mr. Speaker for this opportunity. We understand that one of the critical roles of the County Assembly is oversight. For us to oversight the Executive, this House needs to go into the details of the budget so that we can understand every detail. This is an opportune time for this House to have enough time to scrutinize through the budget and identify the areas that needs some adjustments.

We understand that this could be the final budget that we are doing in this House as we approach the election time. So, there is need for each and every area to be catered for properly in terms of project management and development. I believe this is the best time for us to get ample time to look in to the budget and do what is necessary for the betterment of our *Kilifians*. Thank you. I stand to support.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you hon. Pascal.

Hon. (Ms.) Mbeyu: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I rise to support. We are almost running short of time because the budget should be read before 30th of June. It is the right time for us to include the views of every Member of this Assembly for the benefit of this budget and benefit of the larger Kilifi.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you. Hon. Nzaro, do you wish to make any submissions.

(Question, that the Mover be now called upon to reply, put and agreed to)

Hon. Nzaro: Thank you. I want to congratulate Members who have supported this adjournment Motion. As some of the Members have portrayed that the Constitution we passed in 2010 in Chapter 2, the National values and principles of good governance, you will realize transparency and accountability are values that are supposed to guide us when making decisions on matters of finance in this county.

This will give us an opportunity to look at all those issues which are portrayed in the budget so that they reflect the wishes of the majority of the people of this great county. If you also look at our Standing Order No. 208 (3) it requires that once the estimates have been tabled in this House, the inputs of the Members through their Committee is of paramount importance in the budget making process. That is why when given such an opportunity, the whole Assembly should have an input on the budget.

I moved this Motion and it is very good that Members have also realized that they should look at the budget critically and give their input that will guide us in bringing development in this County. As other Members have said, the paramount duty of this Assembly is oversight; so when we look into this budget we will be doing one of our duties which are enshrined for Members of this Assembly. It is my wish that we get a place outside this Assembly so that Members can relax. With all those activities which happen in their wards, they should be far from them so that they can sit and scrutinize this important function in order to beat the time line which we have in our Constitution. We will scrutinize this Budget from Monday and I think it will be prudent enough for Members to start going to the venue on Sunday so that by Monday at 8 a.m. Members are very comfortable in their places

The Speaker (Hon.) Kahindi: Hon. Japhet Nzaro, the issue was to get an adjournment not to suggest where people are going to.....

(Laughter)

Hon. Nzaro: Thank you Mr. Speaker.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): You only fell short of telling us where to go but I think you should have put it in your Motion.
