THE COUNTY ASSEMBLY STANDING ORDERS

**FIRST SITTING OF THE SECOND ASSEMBLY, DECLARATION OF VACANCY IN
THE OFFICE OF THE SPEAKER AND ELECTION OF THE SPEAKER.**

IT IS NOTIFIED for the information of the general public that pursuant to Article 178 of the Constitution and Standing Order 5 of the County Assembly Standing Orders, the Office of the Speaker of the County Assembly shall become vacant upon the first sitting of the County Assembly on Wednesday, 6th September, 2017 at 9.00 a.m.

Article 178 of the constitution provides that each County Assembly shall have a Speaker elected by the County Assembly from among persons who are not members of the Assembly, who shall be elected by that County Assembly in accordance with the Standing Orders, from among persons who are qualified to be elected as members of County Assembly but are not such members and that the office of Speaker shall become vacant when a new County Assembly first meets after an election.

Pursuant to County Assembly Orders 3, the Governor of the County of **KILIFI** has notified that the first sitting of the County Assembly shall be held at the **County Assembly Buildings, Malindi, on Wednesday, 6th September, 2017 at 9.00 a.m.**

Interested persons who qualify to be elected as Members of County Assembly but are not such members are therefore invited to submit their nomination papers for election to the Office of Speaker of the County Assembly of Kilifi.

Nomination papers can be collected from the Office of the Clerk of the County Assembly at County Assembly of Kilifi Buildings, Malindi, during working hours and on Saturday 2nd September, 2017 and Sunday 3rd September, 2017 between 8.00a.m to 5.00 p.m.

In addition the application must possess the following clearances-;

- i) A clearance from the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission certifying that the candidates is eligible for an election as a member of the County Assembly.
- ii) A current clearance from KRA on payment of taxes applicable to the person.
- iii) A clearance from the Higher Education Loans Board certifying compliance with the terms and conditions of the loan, if not a beneficiary a certificate to that effect.
- iv) A clearance from Credit Reference Bureau
- v) A clearance from the Criminal Investigations Department
- vi) A clearance from the Ethics and Anticorruption Commission
- vii) A dully filled nomination form
- viii) A certified copy of the national ID/Passport
- ix) Certified copies of the Academic certificates

Further to the above, a person who wishes to participate in the election must be nominated by **two (2) Members of the County Assembly of Kilifi.**

Completed nomination papers, together with detailed curriculum vitae of the candidate and **relevant supporting documents**, should be submitted to the Office of the Clerk of the County Assembly at County Buildings, Malindi not later than 10.00 a.m on Monday 4th September, 2017.
