**The Leader of Minority** (Hon. Mumba): Thank you, for this opportunity. I want to say welcome all to this Third Session of this Assembly. I wish it to be very interactive and we shall engage in decorum and have a fruitful engagement throughout the session. I rise to support the Procedural Motion, being that we have no choice but to make sure the House Business Committee is in order because it is the mother Committee which prepares the Business of this House. Without this Committee being in place, the House is equally doomed.

So, I really support that we approve the Members and I want to confirm to this House that these are Members nominated as per the strength of the parties in this Assembly, so we have no doubt that we approve them as Members of the House Business Committee. With these few remarks, Mr. Speaker, I say I support this Motion.

**The Speaker** (Hon. Mwambire): Any Member? Hon. Zia

**Hon. Zia:** Asante sana, Bw. Spika, kwa nafasi ambayo umenipa. Japo tuko Mwezi wa Pili, nafikiri nitasema *Happy New Year* kwa sababu huu mwaka ni mpya na mambo saa hii nafikiri hayatakuwa kama yale ya kawaida huko nyuma ambayo tulikuwa tukifanya. Nimesimama kuunga mkono huu mjadala na Kamati ambayo iko mbele yetu ambayo saa hii tunaipitisha, najua kwamba itakuwa na majukumu yake...

**Hon. Changawa:** Asante, mheshimiwa Spika. Mheshimiwa ambaye yuko kwa Sakafu anasema mambo hayatakuwa ya kawaida. Sasa sijui kama tukiwa tunafanya biashara hapa kuna biashara zingine ambazo sijui si za kawaida na zingine ni za kawaida. Tafadhali aeleze kwa sababu kama tunafanya biashara kujukumikia watu waliotuleta hapa, nafikiri tukiwa hapa tunafanya zile biashara zilizotuleta hapa. Sasa zile ambazo si za kawaida azieleze ni zipi?

**The Speaker** (Hon. Mwambire): Mheshimiwa Zia, umeshtua mheshimiwa Changawa na mumekaa karibu na yeye; anafikiri pengine kutakuwa na kurusha masungwi. Eleza vizuri kwa sababu wengine wanaweza kuwa wameelewa kwamba itafanyika kwa umakinifu zaidi kwa sababu tayari kazi ilikuwa ikifanyika lakini Mheshimiwa anaweza eleza vizuri ili Mheshimiwa Changawa asiwe na hofu na hata wengine ambao pengine wanaweza kuona wakaanza kutoroka. Maana unajua wewe ndio unawakilisha kule upande wa Shakahola sasa hiyo inamshutua Mheshimiwa Changawa sana.

**Hon. Zia:** Ni sawa mheshimiwa. Asante sana kwa hilo swali. Ndungu yangu ni vile tu hayuko na sisi katika haya mazungumzo ndio maana hakunielewa ile *statement* yangu vile ambavyo nilikuwa nasema, maanake anasoma mambo mengine hapa. Nilikuwa nawaambia kwamba kazi...

**Hon. (Ms.) Grace:** Asante, Bw. Spika. Katika hili Bunge sisi sote ni waheshimiwa hakuna cha ndugu wala kaka. Kwa hivyo, mheshimiwa aliye kwa Sakafu akizungumza na kumtaja mheshimiwa asimwite ndugu, amwite mheshimiwa.

**The Speaker** (Hon. Mwambire): Hapa hakuna hata rafiki mheshimiwa Mwangi (Grace)? Endelea, Mheshimiwa Zia.

**Hon. Zia:** Asante sana kwa hayo marekebisho ni kwamba mheshimiwa, nilipokuwa nasema kwamba hayatakuwa ya kawaida nasema kwamba watu watajizatiti kwa kufanya kazi kwa umakinifu zaidi. Kwa hivyo ndio nilikuwa nataka kuelezea zaidi. Asante sana.

**Hon. Brown:** Asante sana, Bw. Spika, kwa fursa hii ambayo maulana ametupatia. Jambo la kwanza ningelipenda kushukuru Maulana kwa huo muda ambao tulikuwa kwa likizo. Ulikuwa muda wa mambo mengi; ulikuwa muda wa kazi nyingi hali kadhalika ulikuwa muda wa sherehe nyingi. Ndani ya wakati huo wote ningelipenda pia kushukuru Bunge hili kwa sababu kwangu haikuwa rahisi ya kuwa ni likizo ya sherehe maana niligundua baba alikuwa anaugua ugonjwa wa *Cancer* katika Desemba hiyo. Nikajaribu kung'ang'ana nione vile nitaokoa maisha yake lakini Mungu naye alikuwa na mipango yake. Alimchukua tarehe 13 mwezi wa kwanza. Nashukuru sana Bunge hili kupitia kwako na uongozi wako kwa vile mlivyosimama na mimi mpaka nikamzika baba na ninaamini kwamba yuko kwa Mungu.

Sasa mimi nimesimama tu jambo la kwanza kushukuru kwa sababu tumeanza muhula huu na pia tumeona kwamba tumezidi kuongeza nguvu katika Kamati kuu ya hizi biashara za Bunge. Mimi naunga mkono maana mabadiliko yeyote katika Bunge ni kwa sababu ya manufaa yetu sisi sote. Kwa hivyo, ninaamini katika uongozi wako, Bw. Spika, Kaunti yetu itafaidika na itazidi kuenda mbele maana tumepiga hatua katika mwaka ambao ulipita saa hii tuko mwaka mwingine, nina amini tutazidi kufanya manufaa zaidi kulingana na mujibu wa sheria ya Bunge. Asante na ni hayo niko nayo kwa leo. Naunga mkono.

**Hon. Hinzano:** Asante sana, mheshimiwa Spika, kwa kunipatia nafasi pia nimshukuru Mwenyezi Mungu kwa muda huu wa likizo ametulinda tukiwa tumerudi katika Bunge hili tukiwa wazima. Kulikuwa na mambo mengi lakini Mwenyezi Mungu pia akatusaidia na pia vile vile naamini kabisa tutazingatia na kusimama na mwongozo wa Bunge japo katika hiyo likizo kulikuwa na mirengo mingi; michakato mingi ya kisiasa lakini nafikiri Spika utasimama ukiwa ni Spika wa Bunge hili na hautakuwa mkereketwa wa Chama kuhakikisha ya kwamba Bunge hili linaenda sawa na mjadala inakuwa ile ya kuongoza ili tuweze kupiga hatua maanake ninaamini uwezo huo uko nao.

Nikisimama, pia, nikijadali ama kuchangia juu ya waliopendekezwa katika hii Kamati ni kwamba bila shaka wataongeza nguvu ya kuweza kuziba ile mianya ambayo pengine ilikuwa inaleta hitilafu kidogo katika kazi za Bunge hili. Walioteuliwa hawa wana uwezo, wana mipango na wako na maono tu mazuri, kwa sababu kwa huu muda tumekuwa hapa katika mjadala na pia katika mazungumzo ya vikao mbali mbali wana uwezo huo wa kutekeleza kazi hizi ambazo wamekabidhiwa. Kwa hivyo, nasimama kuunga mkono kwa dhati ili kuweza kuhakikisha kuwa hawa wanalingia katika hii Kamati ili kupeleka Bunge hili mbele. Asante sana.

**Hon. Rafiki:** Thank you, hon. Speaker. I will not say Happy New Year because I believe we already met here and for the benefit of time, I stand to support. Thank you.

**The Speaker** (Hon. Mwambire): Hon. Members, I do not know whether you can get me there. I think the Leader of Minority was very clear when he said that this is a Procedural Motion in which the names are normally in concurrence with both majority and the minority Parties or both coalitions have agreed on these names.
