**REPORT ON THE PUBLIC FINANCE MANAGEMENT; KILIFI COUNTY ASSEMBLY
STAFF MORTGAGE REGULATIONS, 2015**

Hon. Matano: Thank you Mr. Speaker. On behalf of the Chairperson of the Select Committee on Delegated County Legislation, I beg to move that this County Assembly adopts the Report on the Public Finance Management; Kilifi County Assembly Staff Mortgage Scheme Fund Regulation, 2015 laid on the table of this House on Monday, 15th February, 2016. I would like to ask hon. Muhambi to second.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you, hon. Members. A Motion has been read and is ready for deliberations. I do propose that the same is now ready for debate. Thank you.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Yes hon. Muhambi.

Hon. Muhambi: Asante sana Bw. Spika kwa kunipatia hii nafasi na ninaunga mkono Ripoti hii. Kamati ya *Delegated* tulienda tukaangalia huu Mswada na tukaupitia vizuri sana. THE KILIFI COUNTY TRANSPORT (REGULATION AND CONTROL) BILL, 2015

We are in the Committee of the Whole House this afternoon on the Kilifi County Transport (Regulation and Control) Bill, 2015. Now this is a very long Bill of 146 Clauses and I wish to ask you if you would like us to go through the whole Bill or only on the amended Clauses. Yes, hon. Mangi. Please contribute.

Hon. Mangi: Madam Chairperson, we will just be convinced with the amended Clauses because we trust what is contained in the Bill. So, we can just go over the amended Clauses. Thank you.

The Chairperson (Hon. Ms. Ngala): Any other contributions? Yes Hon. (Ms.) Mbeyu.

Hon. (Ms.) Mbeyu: Thank you Madam Chairperson. I think we will be convinced if we go through the amendments since we trust the Chairperson of the Committee and his Members. So, we will be comfortable with the amended Clauses. Thank you.

The Chairperson (Hon. Ms. Ngala): Thank you Hon. (Ms.) Mbeyu. I think in the absence of no other comment we can start. We will have the Clerk reading the Clauses and then the Chairperson will read the amendments.

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Clause 5

Hon. Mupe: Thank you Madam Chairperson. I beg to move that Clause 5 be amended by deleting the title “Traffic marshal” and replace it thereof with the title “Director”.

**REPORT, CONSIDERATION OF REPORT
AND THIRD READING**

KILIFI COUNTY TRANSPORT (REGULATION AND CONTROL) BILL, 2015

Hon. (Ms.) Ngala: Hon. Speaker. I beg to report that a Committee of the whole House has considered the Kilifi County Transport (Regulation and Control) Bill, 2015 and approved the same with amendments.

Hon. Mupe: Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir. I beg to move that the House do agree with the Committee in the same report. Thank you Sir.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you hon. Members. I now propose the same is ready for debate. Yes Hon. Pascal.

(Question proposed)

Hon. Pascal: Thank you Mr. Speaker, for giving me this opportunity. For a long time as a County we have operated the transport docket without proper legislation that has culminated into too many road accidents that have claimed the lives of the people. That has been calling for us as hon. Members to do a legislation that will receive among other issues the transport docket. Mr. Speaker, as the Chair has put it, we have actually digested and gone through the needs of this Report and as you have been told we have adopted because of the need that is there. So, I call upon my fellow hon. Members to actually support the passage of this. Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you. Hon. Member for Marafa Ward, Yes Hon. Kambi Karisa.

Hon. Karisa: Asante sana Mheshimiwa Spika. Naona ni vyema kwa wakati huu Serikali yetu ya Kilifi iwe na sheria ambazo zitasaidia wananchi wetu. Tumeona maafa ambayo yanatokezea kwa ndugu zetu ambao wanaendesha boda boda na hawazingatii sheria. Kwa wakati huu vile tumeweza kupata sheria ambazo zinaweza kulinda wananchi wetu nafikiri ni bora zaidi. Nasimama kuunga mkono ili sheria hizi ziwekwe kusaidia Serikali yetu ya ugatuzi ya Kilifi. Asante.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you. Hon. Members, the hon. Chairperson moved a Motion for the House to adopt the Report for the said Committee.

(Question put and agreed to)

(Applause)

Hon. Mupe: Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir. I beg to move that Kilifi County Transport (Regulation and Control) Bill, 2015, be now read for the third time.

(Question proposed)

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The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Yes, Hon Teddy Mwambire.

Hon. Mwambire: Thank you very much Mr. Speaker. I am in concurrence for the passage of this legislation because the transportation department has a very hard challenge to undertake the mandate as devolved in the Constitution. Mr. Speaker, there are some noted areas like Malindi, Watamu, Kilifi, Mariakani and Mtwapa. When you are heading to Mombasa in the evening or in the morning when you are moving from Mombasa coming to Kilifi, you will spend over 3 hours but if you look at the legislation which could ease the transportation process, we have never been having it. We have been using the former by-laws to articulate issues that maybe could have taken fast track.

This Assembly has been ridiculed by many because of lack of this legislation. I now congratulate the Committee on Transport for fast tracking this legislation and I know immediately after passage the Governor will assent and start moving ahead. So, we are looking upon the implementation process whereby, I believe it is not only the transportation part but revenue will be enhanced because investors will be in a position to move very fast to their different destination hence stimulating revenue. With those few remarks Mr. Speaker, I stand to support.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you. Hon. Foleni.

Hon. Foleni: Asante sana Mheshimiwa Spika. Naunga mkono sheria hii ili tuweze kuboresha hali ya usalama katika barabara zetu na miji yetu mikuu katika jimbo letu tukufu la Kilifi. Hivyo basi nasimama kuunga mkono. Asante.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Hon. Members, the Hon. Chairperson has moved that the Bill be read for the third time and now I put the question.

(Question put and agreed to)

(Applause)

(The Bill was accordingly read the Third Time with leave of the House and passed)

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Thank you. The Bill having been read for the third time, it is now ready for assent and the same shall be forwarded to his Excellency, the Governor in accordance with the Law. Next order?
