ESTABLISHMENT OF A UNIT TO LINK YOUTHS  
TO OPPORTUNITIES WITHIN THE COUNTY PUBLIC SERVICE

**Hon. Mumba:** Thank you Mr. Speaker and without much ado, I beg to give the following Notice of Motion on establishment of a section or unit to link youths to opportunities within the County Public Service:-

THAT, AWARE THAT, Section 44 (3) (a) of the County Governments Act, 2012 provides that the County Secretary is the head of the County Public Service.

FURTHER AWARE THAT, many youths in Kilifi County in educational training institutions have experienced challenges on internships, attachments and other opportunities within the County Public Service due to lack of an institutional framework and a specific section within the Office of the County Secretary to link them up to all the County Executive Departments.

CONCERNED THAT, the lack of policy and a specific Section or Unit to link the youths to opportunities has resulted to confusion, haphazard and un-structured handling of the internships, attachments and other opportunities with the County Public Service.

NOW THEREFORE, this honourable Assembly urges the County Secretary to develop an Internship Policy and initiate measure for establishment of a section or unit within the Office of the County Secretary that will be a structured and centralized one stop shop for information and all internships, attachments and other opportunities for the deserving persons within the Kilifi County Public Service.

#### ESTABLISHMENT OF PROGRAMMES TO SENSITIZE PEOPLE ON THE MANAGEMENT OF SNAKE BITES

**Hon. Ziro:** Thank you Mr. Speaker. I beg to give a Notice of Motion regarding free administration of snake bites anti-venom in health centres:-

THAT, AWARE THAT, there is an abundance of snakes in various parts of the county mostly in Magarini, Ganze and Kilifi South Sub-Counties, which poses a high mortality rate of snake bites in the county.

FURTHER AWARE THAT, all patients bitten by snakes should be assessed by medically trained staff to determine the species responsible, the amount of venom injected and the variable time course for development of signs, requiring that patients be kept under observation for at least 24hours.

CONCERNED THAT, these incidences of snake bites are a neglected emergency in the county owing to the low awareness of snake bites as a public health problem in the county resulting to victims being maimed and even losing lives.

FURTHER CONCERNED THAT, poor infrastructure and poverty contribute to delays in seeking and receiving treatment for snake bite including the high cost of acquiring and storing the anti-venom.

RECOGNIZING THAT, it is essential for snake bite victims to get supportive care followed by administration of the anti-venom as soon as possible following a snake bite.

NOTING THAT, Article 43(1) (a) of the Constitution provides that every person has the right to the highest attainable standards of health.

NOW THEREFORE, this House urges the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Health services to establish programmes to sensitize people on the management of snake bites and to ensure timely supply and free administration of the anti-venom in at least three health centres in every sub-county, and further ensure that these health centres are equipped with the necessary infrastructure for the storage of the anti-venom.

If yes, what measures is the CECM taking to ensure that the motorbike is returned to the dispensary for the outreach services?

### ABSENCE OF A PLACENTA PIT AT PALAKUMI DISPENSARY

Whether, the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Health Services is aware that Palakumi Dispensary serves a population of over 10,000 people.

Whether, the CECM is aware that the facility attends to more than six cases of delivery per month.

Whether, he is further aware that the said facility has no placenta pit.

If yes, what measure has the CECM taking to correct the situation? Thank you.

### NON-OPERATIONAL HIGH MAST LIGHTS AT FARMERS AREA IN KISUMU NDOGO AND AT KIRAHU IN MTANGANI

**Hon. Kadenge:** Thank you Mr. Speaker. I rise to seek a Statement from the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Roads, Transport and Public Works through the Chairperson; Roads, Transport and Public Works about high mast lights at Farmers area in Kisumu Ndogo and at Kiraho in Mtangani.

Whether, the CECM in charge of Roads, Transport and Public Works is aware that the high mast lights at Farmers area in Kisumu Ndogo and Kiraho in Mtangani have not been in operation for the last six months.

If yes, what measures is the CECM taking to make sure that these high mast lights are in operation? Signed by, hon. David Kadenge.

6. Ruto road bordering Airport to Furunzi road
7. Kanyangwa to Mugurureni road
8. Ganda to Mugurureni road
9. Barclays Bank to Prison Road in Majivuni

Whether the CECM is further aware that the said project was in operation for some time but has been dry for over one year now forcing the area residents to walk for long distances in search of the important commodity which is also very expensive?

If yes, what measures in the CECM taking to solve this problem?
