On behalf of the County Assembly of Kilifi and my own behalf, I welcome you to the Assembly and wish you the best. Hon. Members, also as a matter of practice I will give a few minutes, maximum five, for a Member to acknowledge the presence of these students today. I am informed hon. Mramba had made a request.

**Hon. Mramba:** Thank you Mr. Speaker. I wish to acknowledge the presence of students from Malindi High School together with the teaching fraternity. My name is hon. Nixon Charo Mramba representing Kakuyuni Ward.

Mr. Speaker, Sir, having been a student of Malindi High School; and you already know Malindi high school is an academic giant in the sense that it has produced several leading personalities both in the political sphere and in private life. I wish to congratulate the students of Malindi High School for their good behavior and having been in the forefront of giving us good results. I wish to confirm to you that Malindi High School is still the same high school you left some few years ago. I wish to tell them that whatever you are seeing here today is a product of devolution. **Hon Mramba:** I was giving the example of hon. Peter Ziro because I know very well that he is going to the National Assembly and one of the students by then might take up the seat of Garashi. Mr. Speaker, I wish to encourage them to learn with a lot of discipline.
