STATEMENTS

ORDER OF BUSINESS FOR THE WEEK COMMENCING 25TH FEBRUARY 2019

Hon. Ziro: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I rise under Standing Order 41 sub order two and I wish to present and lay on the table of this House the statement regarding the Business of the House for the week commencing Monday February the 25th 2019 as follows:-

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Today we have two statements; number one, a statement sort by hon. Stanley Kenga from the County Executive Committee Member in charge of the Department of Education and ICT and number two a statement sort by the same hon. Member Stanley Kenga from the County Executive Committee Member in charge of the Department of Health services.

On the 26th day of February 2019, we have two notices of Motions:- number one, Notice of Motion by hon. David Kadenge to the County Secretary and Head of Public Service on performance management in the County Government of Kilifi. Two, we have a Notice of Motion by hon. Hadad Almasi to the Department of Culture and Trade.

Mr. Speaker on the 26th day of February 2019 at 2.30 pm we have one Motion and that is a Motion by hon. Almas Hadad to the Department of Culture and Trade. On the 27th day of February 2019 that is Wednesday 2.30 pm we have one Motion and that is by hon. David Kadenge to the County Secretary and Head of Public Service on performance contract management in the County Government of Kilifi. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): There is an intervention from hon. Ronald Mbura.

Hon. Mbura: Point of Order please Mr. Speaker Sir. I can see here about the Notice of the Motion and the motion raised by hon. Hadad under Department of Culture and Trade. I don't know if we have a Department of Culture and Trade.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Thank you very much hon. Member for raising that intervention. Yes hon. Hadad

Hon. Hadad: Thank you Mr. Speaker. Hon. Member I would like to support the information and actually inform that it's a Motion which is effective in both committees; the committee on Culture and the committee of Trade, That's why it was written Culture and Trade.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Thank you. Well said; it is a Motion that is directed to the two departments: the Department of Culture and the Department of Trade. Yes the Member for Gongoni you may proceed with the statement. The Member for Malindi Town kindly proceed.

KAMALE DISPENSARY OPERATING WITHOUT ELECTRICITY

Hon. Kadenge: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I rise to read a statement on behalf of the Hon. Member representing Garashi Ward. The statement is through the Chairperson Health Services Committee in relation to Kamale dispensary.

Whether the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Health Services is aware that Kamale dispensary in Adu Ward is one of the model dispensaries established by the County Government of Kilifi.

Whether the County executive Committee member in charge of Health Services is aware that Kamale dispensary has been operating with no electricity and solar power since its official opening.

Whether the county executive Committee member in charge of Health Services is aware that the lack of electricity and solar power has hindered emergency response and service delivery at the model dispensary especially during the night.

Whether the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Health Services is further aware that the lack of electricity and solar power has further exposed the health officers and model dispensary to security risks.

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If yes, what measures has the Department put in place to ensure that Kamale dispensary is connected to electricity or solar power to address the challenges. Signed by hon. Stanley Karisa Kenga, MCA Adu Ward.

DAMAGE OF FURNITURE SUPPLIED TO KADZUYUNI AND MWANGANI
EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION CENTRES

Hon. Kadenge: Thank you again Mr. Speaker. I stand on behalf of the MCA Adu Ward Hon. Karisa to read a statement through the chairperson Pre-primary Education and Vocational Training Committee on Kadzuyuni and Mwangani early childhood development centres.

Whether the executive Committee member in charge of Education and ICT is that aware the furniture supplied to Kadzuyuni and Mwangani early childhood education centres in Adu ward got damaged shortly after being delivered and is not in good condition for use.

Whether the Executive Committee Member in charge of Education and ICT is further aware that the bad state of the furniture has affected the pupils and the operations of the two ECD centres.

If yes, what caused the furniture to be damaged in a very short span after delivery and what measures has the Department put to address the challenges above? Signed by hon. Kenga MCA, Adu Ward on 20th February 2019. Thank you.
