AWARE THAT, H.E. the Governor appointed the Ad Hoc Committee to review and recommend Kilifi and Malindi Towns for upgrade to municipality status pursuant to the criteria set out in Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2011.

FURTHER AWARE THAT, the Ad Hoc Committee reviewed the two towns and found that Malindi and Kilifi Towns met the criteria for upgrading and conferment of Municipality status.
