HEALTH HAZARDS OF KIZINGITINI DUMP SITE IN MTEPENI WARD

Hon. Kadenge: Thank you Madam Speaker. On behalf of the hon. Member for Mtepeni Ward, I am here to read his Statement because he is not in. The Statement is to the County Executive Committee Member in charge of the Department of Water, Environment, Natural Resources, Forestry and Solid Waste Management through the Chairperson, Water, Environment and Natural Resources Committee:-

Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Water, Environment, Natural Resources Forestry and Solid Waste is aware that the county government purchased approximately a six acre plot No. KLF/MTWAPA.508-Kizingitini in Mtepeni Ward as a dumping site.

Whether the CECM is aware that the said plot exposes the pupils of Kizingitini ECD centre to the hazards. Whether the CECM is further aware that the dumped waste erodes into the Indian Ocean through Mtwapa Creek hence causing contamination to the Ocean.
