This motion therefore calls the County Executive member in charge of Transport and Public Works to come up with policies to regulate the operations of boda boda and tuk tuk business i.e. wearing of helmets, reflectors, not using phones and earphones when riding, etc so as to curb the menace and strong action taken against perpetrators of the vice so as to bring order and sanity in the boda boda and tuk tuk industry.

Hon. Teddy Mwambire: Department of Land and Settlement Schemes

Aware that, the County Government of Kilifi has established and is still establishing settlement schemes either with or in collaboration with the National Government and/ or the National Land Commissioner. Noting that title deeds have been and will be issued to the beneficiaries of these settlement schemes.
