REDUCTION OF PUBLICATION PERIOD

Hon. Chiriba: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I am standing on behalf of the Chairperson of Budget and Appropriations Committee hon. Albert Kiraga. Despite the fact that he is in the House Mr. Speaker, he is physically challenged somehow and could not take up this matter Mr. Speaker. I beg to move this Procedural Motion:-

THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 116 of the Kilifi County Assembly Standing Orders, I move that this House reduces the publication period of Kilifi County Supplementary Appropriation (No.2) Bill, 2020 from seven (7) days to one (1) day.

In view of our County Assembly Schedule, we are supposed to proceed for our recess which is scheduled for tomorrow. This Bill means a lot for us as a county because it is through the publication of the same that will pave way for the other procedures to follow so as to have the same Bill in our position to be implemented in Kilifi.

Mr. Speaker, also following the directive of His Excellency the President in view of what the world is going through right now that, public gatherings are discouraged, we are also mindful of ourselves and our families. So, if this House can agree with me and reduce the days to one day
