ADOPTION OF THE REPORT ON THE KILIFI COUNTY SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET ESTIMATES (NO. 2) FOR THE YEAR ENDING 30<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2024

**Hon. Emmanuel:** Thank you, hon. Speaker. I beg to move a Motion that this House adopts a Report of the County Budget and Appropriations Committee on the consideration of the Kilifi County Supplementary Budget Estimates (No. 2) for the year ending 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024 laid on the Table of this House on Tuesday, 16<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

Before I call upon hon. Twaher to second, may I take this opportunity to give my remarks on the same. The Supplementary Budget (No.2) for the year ending 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024 has been a very participatory process that included several consultative meetings including the Governor and the whole House. It is my sincere hope that we reach a consensus on this Supplementary Budget today in this House as we will debate that we pass it so that we continue with the projects in our respective wards for the benefit of the Kilifi people. I call upon hon. Twaher to second.

**Hon. Twaher:** Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I stand to support.

**Hon. (Ms.) Maneno:** Thank you, Mr. Speaker, Sir, for giving me this opportunity. I rise to support the adoption of the Report of the County Budget and Appropriations Committee on the consideration of the Kilifi County Supplementary Budget Estimates (No. 2) for the year ending 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024. I am a Member of the Budget Committee. There is money that comes from either the World Bank or mineral royalties; this money cannot be used by the County Government until it is appropriated to the budget of the County of Kilifi. Therefore, I support the adoption so that this House can pass this Report so that the mineral royalties' money can be used in this County. Thank you, Mr. Speaker, Sir.

**Hon. Ngirani:** Thank you, Mr. Speaker, Sir. I rise in support of this document; Supplementary No. 2 of the budget but here are a few areas in which we should probably get clarification from the Budget Committee. The monies that were allocated from the royalties from the budget that was tabled in this House and from the Report from the Budget Committee are two different things. For example, if you go to the breakdown of the mineral royalty's allocation from the Report of the Committee, let us say upgrading of hospitals, I'll go to maybe Ganze dispensary, from the Report of the Budget Committee, Ganze Dispensary has Kshs30 million but from the budget that was tabled before this House, it reads Kshs20 million. I do not know whether the Report from the Committee and the document of the budget that was tabled before this House are two different things. Let us get clarity before we pass the document. Are we passing what was tabled or are we going by the Report of the Committee?

Also, regarding the breakdown of royalties from the Budget Committee, there is a problem with the Water Department. From the budget, Ganze was allocated Kshs30 million for the water project from Silala to Ganze Phase One. If we go by the report there is no such allocation. So, I do not know whether there is a difference between the Committee Report and the budget that was tabled before this House. Can we maybe get a clarification from the Chair before we proceed with passing this important document of the supplementary (No. 2) budget? Thank you.

**The Deputy Speaker** (Hon. Kombo): So, do you support the Motion?

**Hon. Ngirani:** I support the Motion with a few observations and if that can be rectified even the Whole House can know what we are passing.

**The Deputy Speaker** (Hon. Kombo): Okay. Next is hon. Theophilus Fondo.

*(Hon. (Ms.) Radhia stood on a Point of Order)*

**Hon. (Ms.) Radhia:** I am standing on a Point of Order. I want to ask hon. Ngirani if he is supporting the Motion.

**The Deputy Speaker** (Hon. Kombo): That is the question that I asked him, and he said he is supporting.

**Hon. (Ms.) Radhia:** Okay.

**The Deputy Speaker** (Hon. Kombo): I do not see any request so hon. Members, I want to give this opportunity to the Chair Budget to reply before I put the Question.

**Hon. Emmanuel:** Hon. Speaker, do I reply as the Mover, or do I respond to the observations of the hon. Member?

**The Deputy Speaker** (Hon. Kombo): Well, you can do both, you have that opportunity.

**Hon. Emmanuel:** Hon. Speaker, thank you so much for this opportunity. As I had said earlier, this Supplementary Budget followed due process in terms of including all Members in the whole House, including a consultative meeting with the hon. Governor.

I would wish maybe the hon. Member who has been on the Floor maybe to articulate the exact place because what I believe is that the issue of the Report that was tabled by the Majority Leader and the Report that we are giving today is the one that if we accept it here it will be the one that will be used for the project to be done. Instead of Kshs20 million for Ganze for the upgrading hospital will not be Kshs20 million but it will be Kshs30 million. This is because that will be the one that will be uploaded by the Controller of Budget (CoB). So, in terms of rectifying or in terms of saying, which is which, I believe that what we are doing here today is the one that will go into the record and the Kshs30 million will stand in his favour.

Hon. Speaker, today we are doing a very conclusive Report towards the end of the financial year 2023/2024 and as we are here in this honourable House, we are here to append our signatures or append our authority or to authorize this Supplementary Budget for the year ending 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024 and I believe we are all here, we are looking forward to the implementation of our projects and I believe that we are in consensus that this document we do support it and we move. I thank you, hon. Speaker, for giving me this opportunity and I believe that we are on the same page. Thank you.

**The Deputy Speaker** (Hon. Kombo): Thank you Chair...I did not see the interjection until now and the rule is when the Speaker is on his feet, you are not allowed to say anything. So, I want to put the Question now.
