### STATUS OF TUNZANANI DISPENSARY IN KILIFI SOUTH

**Hon. Brown:** Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I want to issue a Statement to the CECM for Health and Sanitation Services through the Chairperson, Health Services Committee on the issue of Tunzanani Dispensary in Kilifi South.

Whether the CECM (County Executive Committee Member) in charge of Health and Sanitation Services is aware that Tunzanani Dispensary in Mtepeni Ward is in a deplorable condition making it unfit for delivery of health services and that leaders and the Health Committee have been advocating for an allocation in the budget for the renovation of the health facility plus a site visit from the Department and there has been no marked progress.

Whether the CECM is further aware that there is no medical officer at the facility but only one nurse plus casuals who have also not been paid therefore affecting the delivery of health services at the facility.

If yes, what immediate and long-term measures is the CECM taking to ensure that there is a delivery of health services and renovation at the dispensary? Thank you, Mr. Speaker, sir.
