CAPITATION GRANT FOR VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRES

Hon. Mohamed: I rise to give Notice of the following Motion: -

THAT, aware that Schedule Four of the Constitution of Kenya mandates the County Government to establish and maintain County Vocational Training Centres as institutions of learning to cater for students who fail to join universities and colleges and complement learning for students who require hands-on technical or entrepreneurial skills gained predominantly through crafts and hand work.

NOTING WITH CONCERN THAT, a vast majority of students joining these institutions are unable to fully meet the tuition fees and other related expenses due to financial constraints compiled with immense economic hardship experiences in the county hence financially shying away from joining these centres or dropping out before course completion.

COGNIZANT TO THE FACT THAT, the National Government through the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology offers financial support to students in

Technical Training Institutes (TTIs) and Vocational Training Centres (VTCs) across the Nation through capitation and HELB (Higher Education Loans Board) loans.

NOW THEREFORE, the House resolves that the County Executive Committee Member in charge of Education introduce a Capitation Grant for County Vocational Training Centres in Kilifi County to help struggling students afford education.
