**Hon. Kea:** Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I beg to move the following Procedural Motion: -

THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 116 of the Kilifi County Assembly Standing Orders, I move that, this House reduces the publication period of the Kilifi County Ward Scholarship Fund (Amendment) Bill (No. 3), 2024 from fourteen (14) days to five (5) days.

It will be of great importance that we reduce this period from 14 days to five days because we want this Bill to be ready just before the schools open for the second term.
