Mr. Speaker, there has been the popular *disco matanga*, which has brought very big issues especially in Kilifi South whereby there are some directives which were given and the National Government purports to have consulted the County Government. As everybody knows,

we do not have such legal parameters in this county but personal aspiration. To avert this, we need to pass this Bill so that this county can have a clear decision but not personal aspirations to override the peoples' investments among other issues.
