**Hon. Pascal:** Thank you for giving me an opportunity to applaud the Second Reading of the Bill. We understand that after the passage of this Bill as proposed, we will see a transformation of the polytechnics that we once had. As we know, these institutions have been turned into dumping grounds for our youth especially those who did not do well in their class eight and secondary education. Time has come for this County Government to come up with a law that will see a transformation and positively move from the olden days where we neglected these kinds of students so that we can build them and make them prosper in their lives.

When you look at this Bill, there are very many good proposals that have been laid across because the name of these institution bearing the name of ‘polytechnics’ will actually change into Vocational Training Centres. Vocational Training Centres are centres that have been given the proper equipment for them to impart knowledge to our youth so that they can have a bright future because we know good skills will be imparted to them.

Again if you go deeper into this Bill, you understand that in the proposal we will have these youth imparted with occupational skills which will assist them in trade and by so doing, we will actually be empowering them with trade skills which will necessitate their enhancement with business skills. This will capture the joblessness in the society. Mr. Speaker, I stand to support the Second Reading of this Bill. Thank you.
