STATEMENT

PRESIDENTIAL DIRECTIVE ON 30 PERCENT GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT ALLOCATION

Hon. Shaban: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I am standing on behalf of hon. Hadad Feisal Almas on a Statement directed to the County Secretary through the Leader of Majority.

Adherence to the Presidential directive that 30 percent of all government procurement be allocated to the Youth, Women and Persons with disabilities.

Whether the County Secretary is aware of the presidential directive dated 25th September 2013 that directs 30 percent of all government tenders to be awarded to the youth, women and Persons with disabilities.

Whether the County Secretary is also aware that following the directive; the Public Procurement Act and disposal (Preferences and Reservations) regulations were amended vide legal Notice no. 114 of 2013.

Whether the County Secretary is further aware that following the directive and subsequent amendment to the regulation, state organs and any other public entity are required to be fair in contracting for procurement of public goods and services including the development of provisions to designate categories of preferences in the allocation of contracts and the protection or advancement of persons, categories of persons or groups previously disadvantaged by unfair competition or discrimination.

If yes, have all the County Departments adhered to the presidential directive in the contracting for the procurement of public goods and services in FY 2017/2018 and FY 2018/2019? And can the County Secretary liaise with the departmental accounting officers and furnish the County Assembly with a detailed report of the implementation of the 30 percent preferences and reservations for women, youth and persons with disabilities in line with the presidential directive for the FY 2017/2018 and 2018/2019.
