Hon. Hassan: Mr. Speaker, Sir, I beg to lay the following Paper on the Table:-

THE KILIFI COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BILL, 2019

Hon. Hassan: Mr. Speaker, Sir, I beg to move that The Kilifi County Solid Waste Management Bill, 2019 be now read a Second Time. I call upon hon. Shaban to second.

(Hon. Shaban seconded)

(Question proposed)

Hon. Shaban: Thank you Mr. Speaker Sir. I rise to second the Kilifi County Solid Waste management Bill, 2019. This is the Bill that will enhance and make sure that we have sanity in the disposal of waste in the county. We have not had a Bill before to regulate and make sure that collected solid waste is being disposed in a good way. So, with this Bill we will have an arrangement on how the waste will be collected right from the household to the disposal areas. I urge Members to support this Bill so that we, the people of Kilifi County, can be able to make sure that our towns and villages are clean. I rest my case.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Yes hon. Matsaki.

Hon. Matsaki: Asante sana Bw. Spika. Nimesimama kuunga mkono kusomwa kwa mara ya pili kwa Mswada huu wa *waste management*. Ukiangalia, kuna vipengee muhimu tofauti ambavyo vimetajwa. Kwanza, jinsi tunavyoweza kuchukua hizo taka mpaka kuzi *dispose*. Nimesimama kuunga mkono na kama Mwenyekiti atakuwa na la kuongezea ...lakini hakuna kitu ambacho hakina sheria. Hizo ni sheria moja wapo ambazo ni muhimu ili kwamba kila kitu katika Kaunti ya Kilifi kiwe kinaenda sawa. Itakuwa ni vyema iwapo watu watajulishwa ni sehemu gani ya kuweka uchafu na ni nani anaenda kuzoa uchafu huu na kupeleka katika sehemu ya kumalizia.

Hon. Mramba: Asante. Naunga mkono kupitishwa kwa sheria hii ambayo angalau italetwa mwamko mpya. Tumeona kwenye sheria hii hata gari ambayo inafaa kubeba takataka imeelezwa ni gari ambalo litakuwa ni la aina gani. Wakati mwingine, unakuta gari linabeba takataka na linaanguka na zinaachwa pale; barabara inanuka kwa sababu hakuna mipangilio maalumu. Hapa imeelezwa wazi gari lenye kubeba takataka lazima liwe *labeled* na lijulishwe kwa mtu yoyote kwamba hili gari limebeba takataka.

Kutakuwa pia na mikakati ya kufunika ili takataka zile zisianguke kila mahali na imeelezwa kabisa ni nani anaweza kubeba takataka sio kwamba uamke leo ununue gari lako na uingilie katika biashara ya kubeba takataka na kwenda tupa.

Kwenye kuondolewa takataka kujulikane na kwenye kutupwa pia kujulikane. Hali hiyo italetwa sheria ambayo itafanya miji yetu iwe safi na mazingira kuwa bora ili kuepuka magonjwa ya kusababishwa na uchafu kutapakaa.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Yes hon. (Ms.) Koki.

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Hon. (Ms.) Koki: Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir. I stand to support the Bill. Just the other day I had visitors from Spain and because I love my county I told them I have to take them round the county. So I came with them to Malindi. When we were going back to Mombasa one thing they told me is Kilifi is blessed, “your county is good but one thing for sure is you need to keep your county clean.”

It really affected me and I had an opportunity of telling them Kilifi is not that dirty and that I would take them to places that are dirty. I wanted to prove that Kilifi is not that dirty because I did not want to accept what they were telling me. I got an opportunity of taking them to Mwakirunge dump site. The separation of waste to organic, plastic, paper and metal can also turn into a source of income. When we went to Mwakirunge, we saw people separating the waste and turning them into money. Even in Kilifi if well maintained and if well handled, we can turn some of this waste into energy. We can turn some of this waste into things that can be used to do other things. We have seen waste of bottles being used to build houses; waste is money. If our waste is well handled, we can also create some income out of it. So, I support the Bill.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Hon (Ms.) Radhia.

Hon (Ms.) Radhia: Asante Bw. Spika kwa kunipa nafasi hii. Mimi pia nimesimama kuunga mkono Mswada huu. Hivi karibuni nilibahatika kwenda Rwanda na bwanangu na niliona mji wa Rwanda ulikuwa safi sana na mzuri sana. Kwa hivyo, nimefurahia sana Mswada kama huu kwa sababu mji wetu utakuwa safi na mji ukiwa safi utavutia watalii. Naona watalii watakuja kwa sababu hawapendi uchafu na wengi wametoroka. Mbali na kutokuwa na usalama, uchafu pia unachangia kutokuja kwao. Mimi ni mmoja katika hili Bunge niliyebahatika kwenda Rwanda na nilivyoona mji wa Rwanda na mimi natarajia Kilifi nayo kutokana na Mswada kama huu tutapata usafi wa hali ya juu. Nimesimama kuunga mkono Mswada huu.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Thank you. Hon. (Ms.) Saumu Sidi.

Hon. (Ms.) Sidi: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I also rise to support this Bill. It is a good Bill but I wish with time as we have that opportunity to amend it we introduce a cleaning day for the whole of Kilifi County especially if the Members both at the County Assembly and Executive will be in the forefront to lead that cleaning day. A very specific one day for cleaning. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Thank you. The Chairperson, your final submissions?

(Question, that the Mover be now called upon to reply, put and agreed to)

Hon. Hassan: Asante mheshimiwa Spika kwa kunipatia nafasi hii. Kwanza napenda kuwashukuru wale waheshimiwa ambao wameunga mkono huu Mswada uwe sheria. Wajibu wetu kama waheshimiwa ni kutengeneza sheria katika Kaunti. Waheshimiwa, mtakubaliana na mimi kwamba katika maeneo mengi sana bila sheria hakuna jambo linaloenda sawa. Kwa hivyo, ombi langu kubwa kabisa kwenu ni kwamba tuiptishe iwe ni sheria ili iweze kutusaidia pamoja na watu wetu katika kujenga mazingira yaliyo bora na mema. Asante sana mheshimiwa Spika.

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Thank you very much.
