Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of Water, Forestry, Environment and Natural resources is aware that there is an asbestos disposal plant at Bwagamoyo village in Mwawesa Ward, Rabai Sub-County?

Whether the CECM in charge is aware that the implementation of the project has exposed the residents to health hazards since asbestos exposure in form of pungent emissions can lead to fibrotic lung diseases (asbestosis) and changes in the lining of the chest cavity (pleura)?

If yes, what measures has the CECM taken to address the concern?
