The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): You are mixing issues. We need to go one by one. We were to start with the Supplementary Budget, isn't it? Hon. Members, the Leader of Majority has the Supplementary Budget Estimates for the financial year 2015/2016. Anybody to second that?

(Hon. Mwambire stood at his place and bowed)

Thank you Hon. Teddy Mwambire. That Supplementary Budget is now committed to the Budget and Appropriations committee. Hon. Chairperson, you will need to work out the Budget. It will take you 14 days according to the law so that you have a look at it and present it back to the House. Where is the Memorandum?

Hon. Members, the Memorandum from the Governor came when this House was on recess and due to the issues of time, I advice that the same be read today and to go back to the Planning Committee. Hon. Dr. Chitibwi, I think you are the one who was working with this Bill. Now I think you all know the Bill, look at it and if you feel the changes made are worth your engagement, you make the changes. If you feel they are not worth in your engagement then you pass it the same way the budget was returned the other time.

The reason why I have asked it to be brought today is because I think it is a very important Bill and for us to have waited until the 8th February, much time could have been eaten. So you have very limited time to look at it. You will be advised by the Office of the Clerk and I think you might need to bring your report before the 8th February, 2016; if am not wrong so that the House reconvenes so that we can get the decision whether you are going by the amendment or you have chosen not to go by the amendments because today's session was only special. We are going back on recess immediately after this, Next order?
