DISPOSAL OF WASTE AT KADZENGO SWAMP AT KIKAMBALA BY PWANI OIL LTD

Hon. Gogo: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I rise to make a Statement to the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of Health and that of Water, Environment, Natural Resources and Solid Waste Management through the Chairpersons of the Committees on Health and Water, Environment and Natural Resources:-

Whether the CECM in charge of Health and the one for Water, Environment, Natural Resources, Forestry and Solid Waste Management is aware that Pwani Oil Limited Company situated at Kikambala disposes their waste which drains from Kikambala Trading Centre to Kadzengo Swamp. This has brought public nuisance and health concerns to the people living around that place.

What measures have the CECMs Water and Health taken to that effect? Thank you.

If yes, what measures is the CECM taking to ensure effective payments of the land rates? Thank you.

STALLED CONSTRUCTION OF THULU ECDE CLASSROOMS

Hon. Kenga: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I have a Statement to the CECM in charge of Education and ICT through the Chairperson, Education Committee at the County Assembly of Kilifi:-

Whether the CECM in charge of Education is aware that the site handing over for the construction of Thulu (2 No.) ECDE classroom was done on 10th March, 2020.

Whether he is further aware that the contractor was given two weeks to mobilize materials and that the project was to be completed within a span of three months.

Whether he is aware that three months down the line the contractor has not shown up on the site and that no construction has taken place?

If yes, has the Department given a warning and/or terminated the contract? What measures is the CECM putting in place to guarantee construction and completion of the said classrooms within this financial year? Thank you.
