STATEMENTS

POOR MAINTENANCE OF THE DRAINAGE SYSTEM IN MTWAPA, SHIMO LA TEWA WARD

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Is the Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson for Roads, Transport and Public works in the House or any Member of the Committee to present the Statement? Yes, hon. (Ms.) Koki.

Hon. (Ms.) Koki: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I am going to read a Response to a Statement from the Department of Roads, Transport and Public Works:-

Kindly receive Responses from the Department as per the County Assembly Statement as requested. First, I will read the Statement sought by hon. Ndago.

Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Roads, Transport and Public Works is aware that the drainage system in Mtwapa in Shimo la Tewa Ward has not been properly maintained due to few workers in place.

If yes, one; who is responsible for maintaining the sewer system in Shimo la Tewa Ward (Attach list of cleaners) and what is the amount paid for the maintenance?

Two, what plans is the CECM putting in place to avoid outbreak of water-borne diseases and other health hazards?

This is the Response; our Department is responsible for construction, maintenance and cleaning of the drainage system. The sewer system is for the Department of Environment and they should always make sure no sewerage system finds its way to the drainage system.

The roads have been rehabilitated by;

A) Ward Development Funds:-

- 1) Custom Beach Road
- 2) Mtomondoni Kwetu Training Centre.

B) Kenya Roads Funds:-

- 1) Furaha Academy –Copa Cabana

This is the list of the roads; Executive, Ward Development Fund (WDF) and Kenya Roads Board (KRB), and as per the list. There is no road allocated funds more than once. Thank you.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Hon. Ndago, are you satisfied with the Response?

Hon. Ndago: Thank you hon. Speaker. According to the Response, I am not satisfied because looking at my Statement, I have actually asked for a drainage system and cleaning of the drainage, but the Response is now talking about the Copa Cabana road and there is no list. I requested the CECM to attach a list of workers. I am not satisfied with the Response. Thank you.

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Hon. (Ms.) Koki, are you in a position to make clarification or you would want to take the matter back to the CECM because he said he is not satisfied and he asked for a list of the workers?

Hon. (Ms.) Koki: Thank you hon. Speaker. The first question was about the drainage system and maintenance of the drainage system is done by the Department of Environment. So I think the question about the drainage should be directed to the Department of Environment. Thank you.

Hon. Ndago: Mr. Speaker, I am the representative of Shimo la Tewa Ward and I am very much aware the drainage system as am talking now and I have a list of the casuals under the Department of Roads, Transport and Public Works who are being paid by the Department and working on the drainage system but it is not the Department of Environment as the Statement has stated. So kindly, I am humbly requesting the hon. Member to come out with the facts because I was not about to comment on the other issues. I was waiting for the other list then I see what I requested was what was responded to. I am not satisfied.

Hon. (Ms.) Koki: Thank you Mr. Speaker. As a Committee, we will take the matter back to the Executive and come back with the list as required. Thank you.

MWAWESA-CHONYI-CHIFERI-BWAGAMOYO ROAD IN MWAWESA WARD

Hon. (Ms.) Koki: I am going to read a Statement sought by hon. (Ms.) Carol Kalume, to the Chairperson; Roads, Transport and Public Works about the Mwawesa-Chonyi-Chiferi-Bwagamoyo Road in Mwawesa Ward:-

Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of Roads, Transport and Public Works is aware that the Mwawesa-Chonyi-Chiferi-Bwagamoyo Road is impassable and that has affected transportation of people, goods and services including food stuff to schools, water boozers and agricultural produce from the area.

Whether he is aware that this is a major road that connects Mwawesa to Mwakirunge Ward in Mombasa County.

Whether he is further aware that the county grader assigned to Rabai Sub-County is currently not operational and that it has never done any road work in Mwawesa Ward for the past three years now.

If yes, what measures is the CECM putting in place to ensure that the situation is rectified in time to enhance the movement of people and goods in the area?

This is the Response titled; Mwawesa Road:

One; Mwawesa-Chonyi-Chiferi-Bwagamoyo Road in Mwawesa:- The road belongs to Kenya Rural Roads Authority (KERRA) for maintenance but because it's not in good condition, we as the Department will write a request to maintain the same through the Kenya Roads Board (KRB).

Two; County Grader: - The grader has a mechanical problem so far and the mechanical teams are on it. Thank you.

Hon. (Ms.) Carol: Thank you very much Mr. Speaker. I am satisfied with the Response and I am looking forward to a positive Response from the KRB. About the county grader, I am also satisfied. Thank you.
