IMPASSABLE ROADS IN GANZE WARD

The Speaker (Hon. Kahindi): Any Member from the Transport Committee who has instructions? The two Statements were from the Committee of Transport and Public Works. The Chairperson is absent, and who is the Vice-Chair? He is also not in? If you are a Member and there is a Response, then you can go ahead and read it.

Hon. (Ms.) Koki: Thank you Mr. Speaker. I will read on behalf of the Chairperson; Reference is made to your letter Ref. CAK/DPT/RODS/9/VOL1/67 dated 16th July 2020 and CAK/DPT/RODS/9/VOL1/73 dated 18th August 2020 on the above subject matter.

Kindly receive Responses from the Department of Roads, Transport and Public Works as per your request concerning the following roads;

1. Charo Marashi- Magogoni Secondary School
2. Kassava-Silala-Ganze Town Road
3. Kitendewa-jila-Dodosa and Mapotea Road and
4. Bale-Danicha Road.

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I am aware that these roads in Ganze Ward were done as per the specifications in the Bill of Quantities (BQs). We are still in the defects liability period which means any defects which occurred during this period shall be rectified before the retention money is released.

INACCESSIBLE ROADS TO BENGONI AND MUDZI MURE ECDS IN MWANAMWINGA WARD

Hon. (Ms.) Koki: I am also aware of the ECD (Early Childhood Development) Centres concerning the access roads; the Department will attend the issue with our available equipment once the fuel hurdle is resolved. Thank you.

Hon. Pascal: Thank you Mr. Speaker for this opportunity to respond to the Response brought before this House. I am not contented with this Response because it is ambiguous; it does not have any timelines, and these are very old centres that have been there for over five years and they have been in this deplorable state. So when the CECM indicates that the problem will be sorted out when the fuel hurdle will be resolved and is not indicating when that will be sorted out, then I think that this Response does not give the weight it deserves. So, I humbly request whoever brought the Response to this House to go back and get the proper timelines of when this problem will be resolved. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

Hon. Chengo: Asante mheshimiwa Spika kwa hii nafasi ili kuweza kujieleza kuhusiana na hii *Statement*. Tunaona ya kwamba huyu Waziri hajafanya jambo kwa sababu hizi barabara ambazo nimezitaja hapa, hakuna hata moja amejibu vile nimekuwa nimeuliza. Hii barabara ya kwa Charo Marashi ni kwamba hakujaenda hata tinga kabisa, na bado iko vile vile, lakini inashangaza kusema kuwa imefanywa. Kwa hivyo, hili jibu mimi nakataa kwa sababu hakuna kitu kimefanyika, barabara ya Bale walilima lakini hawajabadilisha chochote na *bridges* zilikuwa zijengewe lakini hakujafanywa kitu.

Kwa hivyo, naona haya majibu ambayo Waziri ameyaleta hapa sijaridhika nayo. Naomba kwamba waweza kuenda kwa *ground* ili aweze kutupatia jibu mwafaka. Asante mheshimiwa Spika.
