Whether the CECM in charge of the Department of Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries is aware that Rare irrigation scheme feasibility study was carried out in the financial year 2015/2016?

If yes, why has it taken so long to implement the projects? Kindly attach the Report on the feasibility study.

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What plans does the Department have to ensure that the project is implemented to enhance food security to the people of Ganze?

STALLED OPENING AND GRAVELLING OF TSANGALAWENI-DUNGICHA ROAD

Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department in charge of Lands, Energy, Housing, Physical Planning and urban Development is aware that the Tsangalaweni B. Section land adjudication, a project that was budgeted for and initiated in the financial year 2015/2016 at a contract sum of Kshs3.5 million is yet to be completed five years down the line?

If yes, who is the contractor and how much has been paid for the projects so far? Why has it taken so long to complete the project and what action and plans are there to complete the adjudication process for the benefit of the people of Ganze? Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir.
