NOTICE OF MOTION

TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS AND TECHNICAL PERSONNEL TO KILIFI
AND MALINDI MUNICIPALITIES

Hon. Pascal: Thank you Mr. Speaker for this honorable opportunity to give a Notice of Motion that was directed to the County Secretary:-

THAT, Aware that Section 9 (1) of the Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2011 provides that the County Government may on the resolution of the County Assembly confer the status of municipality on a town that meets the criteria set out in Sub-Section (3) by a grant of charter in the prescribed form,

FURTHER AWARE, that the County Assembly clear resolution made in a plenary sitting of Tuesday 9th October 2018 conferred to the status of a municipality on Kilifi and Malindi Towns,

RECOGNIZING THAT, H.E. the Governor pursuant to Section 20 of the Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2011 and Article 5 of the Kilifi and Malindi Charters, the County Executive Committee through the Kenya Gazette Notice Numbers 790 and 791 dated 22nd November, 2019 respectively delegated the functions to be undertaken by the two municipalities.

FURTHER RECOGNIZING THAT, through Kenya Gazette Notice Numbers 790 and 791 the concerned Departments were supposed to transfer or second technical personnel to Kilifi

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and Malindi for effective and efficient service delivery with effect from 21st December, 2019 but some of the Departments are still withholding the functions and the resources,

Cognizant of the fact that, resources should follow functions; now therefore, this House urges the County Executive through the County Secretary to fully transfer to Kilifi and Malindi municipalities the Gazetted functions, the required technical staff and the resources necessary for effective and efficient performance of the functions in the next financial year.

STATEMENTS

DELAYED COMPLETION OF THE GANZE VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTER CLASSROOM PROJECT

Hon. Chengo: Thank you Mr. Speaker for giving me a chance to seek a Statement from the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Education and ICT through the Chairperson; Education Committee on Ganze Vocational Training Center (two number) classroom:-

Whether the CECM in charge of Education and ICT is aware that Ganze Vocational Training Center was allocated two million shillings in the financial year 2017/2018 for a construction of a (two number) classrooms but the project was never implemented. No reason has been given as to why the project has not been implemented.

If yes, what measure is the CECM taking to ensure the project is implemented without any further delays for the benefit of the people of Ganze?

EQUIPPING OF GANZE VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTER

Hon. Chengo: Another Statement to the CECM in charge of the Department of Education and ICT through the Chairperson; Education Committee on equipping of Ganze Vocational Training Center:-

Whether the CECM in charge of Education and ICT is aware that Ganze Youth Polytechnic was allocated Kshs2.1 million in the financial year 2018/2019 for its equipping?

Whether the CECM is aware that the project was tendered and contracted but some of the equipment was not delivered to the institution by the constructor?

If yes, who was the contractor and how much was paid? Why is there delay to deliver the remaining equipment as required? What measure is the CECM taking to ensure that the deliveries are made to the institution for the benefit of the students?

SHODDY KATANA MADEBE-VILAKWE-TSANGALAWENI ROAD WORKS

Hon. Chengo: Another Statement directed to the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of Roads, Transport and Public Works through the Chairperson Committee on Roads, Transport and Public Works on the Katana Madebe-Vilakwe-Tsangalaweni road:-

Whether the CECM in charge of Roads, Transport and Public works is aware that gravelling, culverting and murraming of Katana Madebe-Vilakwe-Tsangalaweni road was budgeted for, tendered and contracted at a cost of Kshs14 million in the financial year 2019/2020.

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Whether the CECM is aware that the project was haphazardly and shoddily done since the contractor did not use the right material as provided in the BQ.

If yes, what measures is the CECM taking to make sure the above mentioned project is done up to the required standards as provided in the BQ?

LACK OF WATER AT THE MALOMANI-VARAVO WATER PIPELINE

Hon. Chengo: The next Statement, Mr. Speaker, is addressed to the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Water, Environment, Natural Resources, Forestry and Solid Waste Management through the Chairperson; Water, Environment and Natural Resources Committee on the Malomani-Varavo Water Pipeline:-

Whether the CECM in charge of the Department of Water, Environment, Natural Resources, Forestry and Solid Waste Management is aware that Malomani-Varavo Water Pipeline project was completed but it had been dry ever since its completion in 2017?

If yes, what is the problem and what measures is the CECM taking to ensure that water flows in the pipeline so that the good people of Ganze can enjoy their right to clean and safe water in adequate quantities? Thank you Mr. Speaker, Sir.

DELAYED PREPARATION OF THE GANZE LOCAL PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT PLANS

Hon. Chengo: The last Statement goes to the Department of Lands, Energy, Housing, Physical Planning and Urban Development through the Chairperson; Lands, Energy, Housing, Physical Planning and Urban Development Committee on Ganze local physical development plans:-

Whether the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) in charge of the Department of Lands, Energy, Housing, Physical Planning and Urban Development is aware that preparation of Ganze local physical development plans, a project budgeted at a cost of four million shillings in the financial year 2016/2017 was tendered and contracted but the works have since stalled?

If yes, who was the contractor and how much has been paid for the works? What reasons have led to the delay in completion of this project? What measures and plans are there to have the project completed so as to meet its intended purposes? Thank you, Mr. Speaker.
