Hon. Mangi: Mr. Speaker, Sir, I beg to move that The Kilifi County Supplementary Appropriation Bill, 2017 be now read a Second Time. I now call upon hon. Chai Chiriba to second.

Hon. Chiriba: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, for giving me this opportunity. I stand to support the Second Reading of the Bill. I want to be brief and say that if this Bill is read for the Second Time, it will be adopted and as we know, the Bill has the mandate to use of funds for the county activities. I wish Members to support the Second Reading so that the activities can start.

The Temporary Speaker (Hon. Kenga): Thank you very much hon. Chiriba for your contributions.

Hon. Nzaro: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I rise to support the adoption of this Report. If you look at the way the Committee did this Report, I think it did ...bearing in mind the issues that we are facing as a county. If you look at the Department of Water for example, they increased the budget. This county has been affected by the issues of drought; I think the Committee did a wonderful job increasing the budget of this Department to improve access to water so that residents can get this commodity because it is a requirement under the Constitution.

Mr. Speaker, on the issue of road network as we speak, we bought graders as a county but there are a lot of challenges in the running of the graders because one of the graders based in our Sub-county in Ganze is idle; it lacks fuel and when we enhance this Department with such monies, it will assist the county in making sure that the roads in this county are accessible.

I kindly support the way the county did its work; for example in the Department of Education, it has been a big challenge in our county because the monies were not utilized. So it was prudent that these monies are channeled to other deserving Departments so that these monies are utilized within the current financial year so that we get rid of the issue of re-voted projects. Thank you Mr. Speaker. I support.
