JIMBA DISPENSARY IN WATAMU WARD

Hon. Maitha: Mr. Speaker, Sir, I am holding brief for hon. George Baya who is not present today. I therefore seek this Statement to the Department of Health Service through the Chairperson Health Services:-

Whether the County Executive Committee (CEC) Member of Health Services is aware that Jimba Dispensary is a two storey building which has been in existence before devolution (2013.) In the financial year 2015/2016, the County Government of Kilifi allocated Kshs9.409 million for renovation of the building. This amount was re-voted in the financial year 2016/2017 and further addition of two million shillings in the Supplementary Budget for the financial year 2017/2018.

Has the contractor raised a certificated of completion? If yes, how much was paid? Further, the CEC of Health Services should provide the Bill of Quantity (BQ) and any other relevant supporting documents which will commensurate with the nature of service provided. Signed by hon.
