FREE MEDICAL SERVICES TO VULNERABLE CITIZENS

The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Mwambire): I was notified that the Mover of the Motion has proposed to defer it to another date. So the House Business Committee will take care of that.

AWARE THAT, Kilifi County has a large number of people aged 65 years and other justified vulnerable citizens who require quality medical care as stipulated in the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.

NOTING THAT, the aged and vulnerable citizens are expected to pay certain levies in our health facilities.

AWARE THAT, most of them are unable to pay these levies due to their status or skip accessing critical services to their health thus endangering their lives through uncalled for sufferings.

This Honourable Assembly urges the County Executive in charge of health services to develop a policy which will acknowledge the aged and other vulnerable citizens in our great County to access free medical services.
