Hon. (Dr.) Chitibwi: Thank you Madam Speaker. As Members, we are aware this Bill is to allow the Executive to implement some of the promises that it made to the people. There were other new items that the Executive was not aware of which came into play particularly on the medical side. It is very important that this year as we go to an election as a County Assembly to show the people that we have done the work for them. Therefore I would like to urge my colleagues in this House to adopt and pass this proposed Supplementary Bill so that the Government can continue with its work. Thank you very much.

Hon. Nzaka: Thank you Madam Speaker for giving me this chance. Allow me first to appreciate the work of the Chairperson Budget Committee. The House had passed the Supplementary Budget and since we passed it without this Appropriation Bill, the supplementary budget cannot do anything. This Appropriation Bill is the one which is going to realize funds from the National Treasury to our County.

We are aware that there are some projects which were under-budgeted and the Executive did their re-allocation within their budget which implies that this financial year we will not re-vote more money to the National Treasury. The other years we were sending huge amounts of money at the Treasury while some people in Ganze and part of Magarini were dying of hunger. This Bill goes hand in hand with the Supplementary Budget which we passed in this House. So I urge my fellow hon. Members after passing this Bill, the Governor is going to assent to it then we are going to receive funds from the National Treasury. Thank you. I urge my fellow hon. Members to support this Bill.
