Further aware that, this has been ongoing for over three months now hence are endangering the livelihood of the traders and the people living around these places. If yes what actions or measures has the County Executive Committee Member taken to that effect? Mr. Speaker, Sir, I want to urge the Chairperson of the said Committee to take this matter with a lot of urgency because Watamu Ward apart from endangering the livelihood of the people it is also a tourist destination. These measures need to be taken as soon as possible. Thank you.

BREAKDOWN OF GARASHI AMBULANCE

The Member for Garashi Ward (Hon. Peter Ngowa Ziro): Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I wish to read the following Statement to the Department of Health through the Chairperson of the Health Committee on the breakdown of the ambulance. I wish to ask whether the Executive Committee Member in charge of Health Services, is aware that the ambulance from Garashi Ward (03CG-010A) has not been operational for over one month now.

Noting with concern that, this has made it difficult for patients referred in cases of emergencies like snake bites, to access proper medication from other health facilities in good time hence endangering their lives. If yes what measures has the Department taken to address this concern. Thank you.
